ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

DAVID TOWNER BARRED

The Commission announced the entry of an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings Pursuant to Section 203(f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 on August 10 against David J. Towner (Towner) of Exeter, New Hampshire. The Order bars Towner from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. Simultaneously, Towner consented to the entry of the Order.

The Commission's Order finds that from at least January 1988 through March 1993 Towner willfully violated the Advisers Act by operating as an investment adviser without registering with the Commission. The Order specifically finds that Towner held himself out to the public as an investment adviser by maintaining an office at a securities broker-dealer that was open to the public, by accepting new clients through referrals and by representing that he was a registered investment adviser.

The Order also finds that Towner pled guilty to one count of conspiracy and one count of bank bribery in <u>U.S. v. Towner</u>, (Cr. 92-75-01D). The Criminal Information alleged that from in or about 1980 through October 30, 1987 Towner knowingly and willfully accepted bribes from two registered representatives in connection with transactions and business of a bank for which he was an officer. The Commission's Order barring Towner is based on both his criminal conviction and his failure to register. (Rel. IA-1434)

NASD DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST JOEL EUGENE SHAW SUSTAINED

The Commission has sustained the NASD's findings of violation against Joel Eugene Shaw of Greenville, South Carolina. The Commission found that Shaw made improper use of a customer's funds and falsified records to prevent the discovery of his conversion. The NASD censured Shaw, fined him \$10,000 and barred him from association with any member.

The Commission rejected Shaw's contentions that the sanctions imposed by the NASD should be reduced because he was under extreme emotional stress as a result of severe financial problems and his parents' and children's ill health, that he has made full restitution to his customer, and that he had made a sincere effort to cooperate fully with the NASD. The Commission noted that conversion of a customer's fund cannot be justified by personal and financial circumstances. The Commission stated that Shaw's conduct could hardly be more serious. (Rel. 34-34509)

NASD ACTION AGAINST CHARLES STEDMAN SUSTAINED

The Commission has sustained findings of violation by the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (NASD) against Charles R. Stedman, a former registered representative of Prudential Securities, Inc., a member of the NASD. The gravamen of the complaint against Stedman was his failure to respond to the NASD's request for information in connection with its investigation of an allegation that Stedman misappropriated money from a former customer's account. The Commission sustained the NASD's sanctions of a censure, a fine of \$20,000 and a bar from associating with any NASD member in any capacity.

The Commission noted that it has repeatedly held that engaging in dilatory tactics in responding to an NASD information request constitutes a failure to report under Article IV, Section 5 of the NASD's Rules of Fair Practice. The Commission found that Stedman engaged in such dilatory tactics by failing to provide complete, timely responses to the NASD's requests for information in connection with its investigation. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FINANCIAL HORIZONS LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Financial Horizons Life Insurance Company, Financial Horizons VA Separate Account-3 (Account) and Nationwide Financial Services, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The order provides exemptions to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of a mortality and expense risk charge from the assets of the Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-20475 - August 15)

CAMBRIDGE SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Cambridge Series Trust, et al. from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The order permits certain open-end management investment companies to issue multiple classes of shares representing interests in the same portfolio of securities, and assess and, under certain circumstances, waive a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of shares. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change, as amended by Amendment Nos. 1-8 (SR-NASD-93-03) to amend Article III, Section 34 of the NASD Rules of Fair Practice. proposed rule change would amend Article III, Section 34 of the Rules of Fair Practice to include rules which prevent NASD members or persons associated with an NASD member from participating in any "limited partnership rollup transaction" (as defined in the proposed rule change) unless the transaction includes certain specified provisions designed to protect the rights of limited partners. The proposed rule change also would amend Article III, Section 34(b)(6) to narrow the scope of transactions in which members are forbidden to receive differential compensation (Differential Compensation Amendment). Finally, the proposed rule change would amend Schedule D of the By-Laws (Schedule D) to prohibit the authorization for quotation on the Nasdaq National Market (Nasdaq/NM) of any security which results from a covered partnership rollup transaction unless the transaction was conducted in accordance with certain specified procedures designed to protect the rights of dissenting limited partners.

The Commission solicits comment on the Differential Compensation Amendment; approves the proposed rule change as amended by Amendment Nos. 1-4; and grants approval on an accelerated basis to Amendment Nos. 5, 6 and 8, and grants approval on an accelerated basis to Amendment No. 7, except for that portion of that Amendment proposing the Differential Compensation Amendment. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 22. (Rel. 34-34533)
