## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### DOUGLAS MAXWELL BARRED WITH RIGHT TO REAPPLY IN FIVE YEARS AND PDS INTERNATIONAL SECURITIES, INC. REGISTRATION REVOKED

The Commission announced the institution of public proceedings against PDS Securities International, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, and its President, Douglas I. Maxwell. Simultaneously with the institution of these proceedings, PDS and Maxwell submitted an offer of settlement. Without admitting or denying the findings contained in the Commission's order, except for the finding that they were permanently enjoined, PDS and Maxwell consented to the entry of the Order instituting proceedings, making findings and imposing remedial sanctions. The Order finds that PDS and Maxwell violated the general antifraud provisions of the federal securities laws, that Maxwell aided and abetted PDS's violations of the broker-dealer antifraud provisions, and that they were permanently enjoined from further violations of these provisions. PDS and Maxwell raised over \$1 million from investors through the fraudulent offer and sale of securities in the form of limited partnership interests. The Commission revoked PDS's registration and barred Maxwell from association with the securities industry for five years. (Rel. 34-30165)

DR FUNDS INC.

An order has been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that DR Funds Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18477 - January 10)

G.T. GLOBAL GROWTH SERIES, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting G.T. Global Growth Series, et al. from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit them to acquire securities of certain foreign issuers engaged in securities related activities in accordance with the conditions of the proposed amendments to Rule 12d3-1. (Rel. IC-18478; International Series Rel. 358 - January 13)

MARINER MUTUAL FUNDS TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 10 to request a hearing on an application filed by Mariner Mutual Funds Trust and Mariner Funds Trust for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order would exempt applicants from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit applicants' underlying portfolios to invest in equity securities issued by foreign companies that, in each of their most recent fiscal years, derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as brokers, dealers, underwriters or investment advisers, provided such investments meet the conditions in the proposed amendments to Rule 12d3-1. (Rel. IC-18485; International Series Rel. 359 - January 14)

PILGRIM MONEY MARKET FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pilgrim Money Market Fund for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18486 - January 14)

**HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER CO., INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by American Electric Power Co., Inc. (American), a registered electric public-utility holding company, its electric utility subsidiaries, Appalachian Power Co., Columbus Southern Power Co., Indiana Michigan Power Co., Kentucky Power Co., Kingsport Power Co., Ohio Power Co. and Wheeling Power Co. (collectively, Subsidiaries), and American's service subsidiary, American Electric Power Service Corporation (Service). Subsidiaries and Service are authorized to issue and sell an aggregate principal amount of \$790 million of unsecured promissory notes (Notes) to one or more financial institutions or institutional investors pursuant to a term loan agreement (Agreement). In addition, American is authorized to unconditionally guarantee the Notes and the Agreement for Service. Subsidiaries and Service are authorized to use the proceeds from the Notes and other available funds to pay at or prior to maturity certain long-term and short-term debt. (Rel. 35-25451)

EASTERN UTILITIES ASSOCIATES, ET AL.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing EUA Ocean State Corporation, a subsidiary company of Eastern Utilities Associates, a registered holding company, to issue and sell through December 31, 1992 up to \$46 million of long-term unsecured notes (Notes). Jurisdiction has been reserved over the issuance and sale of up to \$29 million of Notes. (Rel. 35-25453)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
