NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday mornings. Meetings on Wednesdays, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

CHANGE IN THE MEETING: ADDITIONAL ITEMS

The following items were inadvertently omitted from the notice of the Commission's open meeting to be held March 11 at 9:00 a.m.:

1. Consideration of whether to send to Congress proposed legislation that would amend the Investment Company Act of 1940 to (1) lessen restrictions in both the exception from the Act's regulation for "private" investment companies (Section 3(c)(1) and the exemption for "intrastate" investment companies (Section 6(d)); (2) add two new provisions, one excepting companies whose securities are held exclusively by sophisticated investors, as defined by the Commission, and the other exempting certain state-regulated business and industrial development companies; and (3) to reduce the extent to which business development companies have to provide managerial assistance to small businesses, allow business development companies flexibility in acquiring portfolio securities from persons other than the issuer, permit business development companies to issue multiple classes of publicly held debt, and allow business development companies more flexibility in issuing warrants, options and rights.
2. Consideration of whether to send to Congress proposed legislation that would amend the Securities Act of 1933 to increase the dollar limit of offerings over which the Commission has exemptive authority under Section 3(b) from \$5,000,000 to \$10,000,000.

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LOUISIANA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Louisiana Power & Light Company (LP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. LP&L proposes to increase from \$200 million to \$500 million the amount of first mortgage bonds (Bonds) it is authorized to issue and sell and from \$250 million to \$550 million the amount of its outstanding first mortgage bonds it may repurchase. Jurisdiction will continue to be reserved over LP&L's proposal to issue and sell up to an additional \$115 million of preferred stock under an exception from competitive bidding. Jurisdiction will also continue to be reserved over LP&L's proposal to issue and sell up to \$500 million aggregate principal amount of Bonds under an exception from competitive bidding. Finally, jurisdiction will continue to be reserved over LP&L's proposal to arrange for the issuance of an irrevocable letter of credit and/or secure an insurance policy, either or both in favor of a trustee, for the payments of the principal of and/or premium on one or more series of tax-exempt bonds, which are to be issued and sold by the Parish of St. Charles, Louisiana. GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU), a registered holding company. GPU proposes to make cash capital contributions through December 31, 1993 to its three electric public-utility subsidiary companies in the following amounts: \$100 million for Jersey Central Power & Light, \$50 million for Metropolitan Edison Company and \$50 million for Pennsylvania Electric Company. CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company, to adopt, subject to shareholder approval at the 1992 annual meeting, a Long-Term Incentive Plan (Incentive Plan) and a Directors Restricted Stock Plan (Directors Plan). Under the Incentive Plan, CSW proposes to issue and grant from time to time through December 31, 2001, to certain key employees stock options, stock appreciation rights, performance units, phantom stock and restricted shares of CSW common stock. The maximum number of shares of common stock, par value \$3.50 per share (Common Stock), subject to such awards is limited to 4 million. Under the Directors Plan, CSW proposes to issue from time to time through December 31, 2002, to non-employee directors, up to 100,000 shares of restricted Common Stock as part of their annual retainer fee. In addition, CSW has been authorized to solicit proxies from its shareholders in connection with obtaining approval for the two plans at its April 16, 1992 annual meeting. (Rel. 35-25487)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company (Southern), a registered holding company, and its public utility subsidiaries, Alabama Power Company (Alabama), Georgia Power Company (Georgia), Gulf Power Company (Gulf), Mississippi Power Company (Mississippi), Savannah Electric and Power Company (Savannah) and Southern Electric Generating Company (SEGCO) (collectively, Applicants). The proposal seeks through March 31, 1994 for the Applicants to issue and sell from time to time up to the aggregate principal amounts of \$500 million for Southern, \$450 million for Alabama, \$800 million for Georgia, \$100 million for Gulf, \$140 million for Mississippi, \$60 million for Savannah and \$100 million for SEGCO, short-term and/or term loan notes to banks, commercial paper to dealers and/or non-negotiable promissory notes to public entities in connection with the financing of certain pollution control facilities through the issuance by such public entities of their revenue bond anticipation notes. AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 30 to request a hearing on a proposal by American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company. AEP proposes to make capital contributions through December 31, 1993 to two of its electric public-utility subsidiary companies in the following amounts: up to \$30 million for Indiana Michigan Power Company and an increase in the total authorized amount from \$40 million to \$70 million for Columbus Southern Power Company. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-92-07) filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange which allows the CBOE to list capped Standard & Poor's 100 Index options with a March 1992 expiration has become effective upon filing with the Commission. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
