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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ASSETS OF FIVE BLIND POOL ISSUERS FROZEN

The Chicago Regional Office filed a Complaint on January 12 in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois against Carl Porto, Charles Scheuerman, Mary Armeni, Jerome Teppes, Michael Goldstein, Sheppard Resources, Inc., Pilgrim Venture Corporation, Vanguard Financial, Inc., Chatsworth Enterprises, Inc., and Transworld Network Corporation, seeking preliminary and permanent injunctions and other ancillary relief against them for violations of the antifraud, registration, and reporting provisions of the securities laws.

In essence, the Complaint alleged that the defendants engaged in a scheme to defraud that involved, among other things, creating and covertly controlling the five defendant companies, raising money from the public through blind pool offerings on Form S-18, misappropriating money raised from the investors, disseminating false and misleading information about the defendant companies to the public, and engaging in kickback schemes. The Complaint further alleges that the scheme to defraud included making false filings with the Commission and others and forging, or otherwise affixing without authorization, numerous signatures.

On January 19, on the Commission's motion, U.S. District Judge Nicholas J. Bua froze the assets of the defendant companies. (SEC v. Carl Porto, et al., NDIL, Civil Action No. 88 C 0239). (LR-11659)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### DELAWARE GROUP CALIFORNIA TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

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### AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

### ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

Jurisdiction has been reserved over the terms and conditions of the issuance and sale of an additional \$50 million of preferred stock and over certain other matters, pending completion of the record. ### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved the following proposed rule changes filed by The New York Stock Exchange: (SR-NYSE-86-22) that amends the registration and reporting requirements for employees of member firms, expands the definition of the term registered representative, and adopts an ethics agreement for securities lending representatives as an addendum to Form U-4. (Rel. 34-25312); and (SR-NYSE-87-50) that revises its initial bond listing fees and fees for a relisting or change in obligor, effective January 1, 1988, and that establishes an 18-month program of reduced fees for outstanding unlisted debt, effective from the date of the approval order.
