### OPEN MEETING - THURSDAY, MARCH 3, 1987 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the March 3 open meeting will be:

Consideration of whether to publish two releases relating to Regulation D, the limited offering exemptions from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933. The first release would in effect: (1) revise the definition of "accredited investor"; (2) raise the dollar ceiling for certain offerings under Rule 504 and adjust the general solicitations standard for Rule 504 offerings; (3) revise certain conditions to the exemption; (4) provide a substantial and good-faith compliance standard for procedural requirements; and (5) make certain technical amendments to the regulation. ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-87-1) to permit use of the General Securities Representative (Series 7) Examination and its Study Outline and use of the Uniform Application for Securities Industry Registration or Transfer (Form U-4). (Rel. 34-25361); The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-88-1) to extend the AUTO-EX pilot plan for emergency situations until June 30, 1988. (Rel. 34-25380); and The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-5) to amend Part III, Sections 13, 19, and 43 of its Code of Arbitration Procedure to raise the limit on the size of claims eligible for simplified arbitration procedures from \$5,000 to \$10,000, to establish a filing fee of \$200 where the amount in controversy is between \$5,000 to \$10,000, to eliminate the requirement for five member panels in claims exceeding \$500,000, and to increase administrative fees retained for cases withdrawn or settled prior to their first hearing session. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of February 22, 29, and 22 respectively.

## IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-NASD-88-3) amends Section 12 of Schedule A of the NASD's By-Laws to raise the application fee imposed on member firms that file applications for approval to employ or to continue to employ as an associated person, any individual subject to a statutory disqualification from \$500 to \$1,000. ## ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
