COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED CHALLENGING NEW YORK TAKEOVER LAW AS UNCONSTITUTIONAL

General Counsel Daniel L. Goelzer announced that the Commission has submitted for filing in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, a friend-of-the-court brief in Salant Acquisition Corp. v. Manhattan Industries, Inc. In that case Salant, which has made a tender offer for the stock of Manhattan Industries, contends that a New York law regulating takeover bids is unconstitutional. The Commission's brief agrees that the New York law is unconstitutional. (Press Release 88-21)

JULIO A. MOJICA APPOINTMENT ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, DIVISION OF MARKET REGULATION

Richard Ketchum, Director of the Division of Market Regulation, announced the appointment of Julio A. Mojica as Assistant Director, Market Operations and Surveillance, in the Division's Office of Inspections and Financial Responsibility. Mr. Mojica will be responsible for the Division's program of inspecting the operations and surveillance programs of the self-regulatory organizations.

Since July 1984, Mr. Mojica has been Branch Chief for the Branch of Financial Responsibility in the Division. Mr. Mojica obtained a B.A. degree, magna cum laude, in Political Science from Fordham University in 1978, and a J.D. degree from Columbia University School of Law in 1981. Mr. Mojica joined the Commission in 1981 as a staff attorney in the Division.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST HORIZONS RESEARCH LABORATORIES, INC. AND ANANT K. NIGAM

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on February 29 U.S. District Judge William J. Zloch, Southern District of Florida, entered a temporary restraining order against Horizons Research Laboratories, Inc. and Anant K. Nigam, of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The temporary restraining order restrains the defendants from violating the antifraud and registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud and broker registration provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The February 29 complaint alleges that Horizons and Nigam operated an unregistered broker-dealer and sold unregistered securities in the form of limited partnership interests, and obtained money from investors by making misrepresentations and omitting to disclose material facts including, among other things, making projections of future income without any reasonable basis for making the projections. A hearing on the Commission's motion for preliminary injunction has been scheduled for March 10, 1988. (SEC v. Horizons Research Laboratories, Inc. and Anant K. Nigam, Civil Action No. 88-6144-CIV-ZLOCH). (LR-11680)
