ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

STEVEN E. WHITING BARRED

Public administrative proceedings have been instituted under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Section 14(b) of the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 against Steven E. Whiting. Simultaneously, Whiting submitted an Offer of Settlement which the Commission accepted for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by these proceedings. Whiting consented to Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions which find that Whiting was permanently enjoined on March 22 by the District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin from further violations of Sections 17(a)(1), 17(a)(2), and 17(a)(3) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5, and from aiding and abetting violations of Sections 15(c)(3) and 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 15c3-1, 15c3-3, 17a-3, and 17a-11.

The Commission permanently barred Whiting from any association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer. (Rel. 34-25779)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST PAUL GOLDBERG

Public administrative proceedings have been ordered under Section 15(b)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Paul Goldberg.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that on April 21, 1987, Goldberg was convicted of conspiracy and mail fraud in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York. In addition, the Order alleges that Goldberg consented to a permanent injunction in the same District Court restraining him from further mail and wire fraud activities, and also enjoining him for five years from offering for sale any security or commodity by means of telephone or direct mail solicitation. The Order also alleges that Goldberg was permanently enjoined in the New York Supreme Court from violations of various provisions of the New York State General Business Law and Executive Law, and from any fraudulent offering or sale of securities.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Goldberg are true, and if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-25781)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

DAVID ALVIN HUNT PLEADS GUILTY

The Seattle Regional Office announced that on May 13 David Alvin Hunt pled guilty to a three-count information charging him with mail, tax, and securities fraud in a scheme involving 400 victims and over seven million dollars in the use of a "brass plate" (name on a door only) offshore bank scheme through the sale of stock of First Colonial Bank. (U.S. v. David A. Hunt, USDC WDWA, No. CR-88-52T). (LR-11762)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
