COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC RELEASES POLICY STATEMENT ON REGULATION OF INTERNATIONAL SECURITIES MARKETS

The Commission today released a policy statement on regulation of international securities markets. The policy statement, approved unanimously by the Commission, is being delivered in Melbourne, Australia, by David S. Ruder, Chairman, at the Annual Conference of the International Organization of Securities Commissions. It stresses approaches for developing internationally efficient structures for market information, sound disclosure systems, and fair and honest markets. (Press Rel. 88-106)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED, SANCTIONS IMPOSED AGAINST EUGENE B. GARRETT

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Eugene B. Garrett, former manager of the Naples office of Charles Phillip Elliott, doing business as Elliott Enterprises, an unincorporated business with offices in Fort Myers and Naples, Florida, and the former manager of the Naples office of Elliott Securities, Inc., a registered broker-dealer.

Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Garrett's Offer of Settlement. The Offer of Settlement consents to, and the Commission entered: (1) findings that Garrett violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act, and that he aided and abetted violations by a broker-dealer of the broker-dealer registration provisions of the Exchange Act; and further finds that a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction was entered against him on April 10, 1987; and (2) an Order barring Garrett from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser, or investment company.

The Commission found that Garrett violated the antifraud provisions by making various misrepresentations to investors in connection with the sale of certain debt securities including, among other things, claiming that interest payments to the investors would be tax free, when they were not. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BALDWIN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued exempting Baldwin Life Insurance Company, Baldwin Variable Annuity Account, and CNL, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ORLEANS PUBLIC SERVICE, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing New Orleans Public Service, Inc. (NOPSI), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to amend its Articles of Incorporation to effect a reduction of the par value of its common stock from \$10 to \$4 par value per share, subject to the consent of Middle South as sole holder of the common stock, thereby permitting NOPSI to restructure its capital accounts and facilitate the payment of dividends on its 4-3/4% preferred stock and serial preferred stock, respectively, out of capital surplus or future credits to earned surplus. HOLYOKE WATER POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Holyoke Water Power Company, subsidiary of Northeast Utilities, to refinance up to \$8 million of pollution control revenue bonds. (Rel. 35-24742 - Nov. 9)

An order has been issued authorizing Appalachian Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., to sell certain utility assets to GTE South, Inc. (Rel. 35-24743 - Nov. 9)
