INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SHEARSON LEHMAN BROTHERS APPRECIATION FUND INC., ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Act on an application by Shearson Lehman Brothers Appreciation Fund Inc. and other members of the Shearson group of investment companies (Funds), their distributor, and their respective investment advisers to amend a prior order that granted exemptive relief from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 18(f), 18(g), 18(i), 22(c), and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder. The prior order allowed the creation of multiple class and contingent deferred sales load arrangements. The amended order allows the Funds to issue and sell additional classes of shares and to modify the deferred sales load arrangement. (Rel. IC-19216 - January 19)

THE ASO OUTLOOK GROUP, ET AL.

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Act on an application by The ASO Outlook Group and certain other registered investment companies (Funds), their respective advisers, and The Winsbury Company, the principal underwriter for the Funds, granting an exemption from Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Act to enable the Funds to create multiple classes of shares. (Rel. IC-19217 - January 19)

DECLARATION FUND, ET AL.

A conditional order has been issued on an application filed by Declaration Fund, Declaration Service Company, and Consistent Asset Management Company, Inc. under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from the provisions of Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Act so that certain series of Declaration Fund may issue two classes of shares. The two classes of shares will be identical in all respects except for differences relating to class designations, the allocation of certain expenses, voting rights and exchange privileges. (Rel. IC-19218 - January 19)

SCHWARTZ INVESTMENT TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Schwartz Investment Trust, et al. pursuant to Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Act to permit an exchange of shares of The RCM Fund, a series of Schwartz Investment Trust, for portfolio securities of RCM Partners Limited Partnership. (Rel. IC-19219 - January 19)

SECURITY FIRST LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 16, 1993 to request a hearing on an application by Security First Life Insurance Company, Security First Life Separate Account A (Separate Account A) and Security First Life Separate Account B (Separate Account B) for an order of the Commission under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt Applicants from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit the merger of Separate Account B into Separate Account A. (Rel. IC-19220 - January 19)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. MP&L proposes to increase the aggregate principal amount of its General and Refunding Mortgage Bonds (Bonds) MP&L is presently authorized to issue and sell by \$150 million, to not more than \$235 million, under the same terms and conditions. MP&L also proposed to issue and sell up to \$125 million of a new series of Bonds pursuant to a negotiated public offering. (Rel. 35-25737)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of Nu Horizons Electronics Corp. to withdraw from listing and registration its Common Stock, \$.01 Par Value, on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-31737)

UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES SOUGHT

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 9, 1993 to comment on the applications of five exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. The exchanges and number of issues are as follows: Midwest Stock Exchange - 8 issues (Rel. 34-31738); Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 33 issues (Rel. 34-31739); Pacific Stock Exchange - 1 issue (Rel. 34-31740); Boston Stock Exchange - 8 issues (Rel. 34-31741); and Philadelphia Stock Exchange - 8 issues (Rel. 34-31742).

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 5, 1993 to comment on the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in one over-the-counter issue: Ask Computers Systems. (Rel. 34-31745)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-55) to amend Part VI, Section 1 of Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws to require members to append a fifth-character indicator to their market making symbol when a trading desk is located somewhere other than the firm's primary trading location. (Rel. 34-31728)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-54) that would modify the operational rules, primarily those applicable to market maker participants, governing the Nasdaq International Service. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 18. (Rel. 34-31731; International Series Rel. 518)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-92-56) to amend Parts XII and XIII of Schedule D and Section 2 to Schedule G to the By-Laws and to the Automated Confirmation Transaction Service (ACT Rules) to require members to input the time of execution on late trade reports, to require trade reporting for transactions in Nasdaq securities between the hours of 9:00 and 9:30 a.m. Eastern Time and to add a section regarding audit trail data. (Rel. 34-31735)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-91-61). The filing amended Section 59 of the Uniform Practice Code (UPC) to establish failure to deliver and liability notice procedures for foreign currency, index warrants and similar instruments. The proposal also amended Section 65 of the UPC to establish procedures to ensure that customer accounts are transferred in a timely manner. Finally, the proposal amended Section 65 of the UPC to institute close-out and sell-out procedures for fail contracts. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 18. (Rel. 34-31730)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-92-38) to disseminate opening order imbalances in certain stocks in the S&P MidCap 400 Index on expiration Fridays. (Rel. 34-31732)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-92-40) to extend the use of quarterly expiration Friday auxiliary opening procedures to monthly expiration Fridays. (Rel. 34-31733)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-93-02) which amends Amex Rule 903C(b) to allow the Amex to list additional series of European-style stock index options which are greater than 15% or 50 points of the current index value (whichever is less) but do not exceed

30% or 100 points of the current index value (whichever is less) provided that demonstrated customer interest exists prior to the listing of such series. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 18. (Rel. 34-31743)

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-93-01) which amends CBOE Rule 24.9, Interpretation .05 to allow the CBOE to list additional series of European-style index options in response to demonstrated customer interest provided that the new strike prices are no more than the lesser of approximately 100 points away from the current index value or 30% away from the current index value. The proposal also codifies an existing interpretation of Interpretation .05 which provides that the exercise price of an index option is "reasonably related" to the current index value if the exercise price is within no more than the lesser of 50 points of the current value of the index or 15% of the current index value. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 18. (Rel. 34-31744)

TEMPORARY ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval, on a temporary basis until April 16, 1993, to a proposed rule change submitted by the Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-93-01) relating to examination specifications for its Floor Member Examination. (Rel. 34-31736)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
