OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 15, 1993 - 9:30 A.M.

The subject matter of the December 15 open meeting will be:

1. Consideration of whether to issue a release proposing for public comment amendments to the proxy rules applicable to registered investment companies under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Amendments would revise the information required in investment company proxy statements. For further information, please contact Kathleen K. Clarke at (202) 272-2097.
2. Consideration of whether to propose for public comment Rule 18f-3 under the Investment Company Act of 1940, and an amendment to Rule 12b-1 under the Act. Rule 18f-3 would exempt mutual funds that issue multiple classes of shares from certain restrictions on "senior securities" in Section 18 of the Act. The amendment to Rule 12b-1 would clarify the applicability of the rule to multiple class funds. Additionally, the Commission is considering whether to propose for public comment amendments to Forms N-1A, N-14, and N-SAR, Rule 34b-1 under the Act, and Rules 134 and 482 under the Securities Act of 1933. These amendments would add certain disclosure requirements for multiple class funds and funds using the two-tier "master-feeder" structure. 3. Consideration of whether to propose for public comment amendments to rules and forms under the Securities Act of 1933 and the Investment Company Act of 1940 that govern money market funds. The proposed amendments would tighten the risk-limiting conditions imposed on tax exempt money market funds by Rule 2a-7 under

the Investment Company Act of 1940; impose additional disclosure requirements on tax exempt funds; and make certain other changes to the Commission rules and forms applicable to all money market funds. For further information, please contact Martha Platt at (202) 504-2838

PROCEDURES FOR EARLY STAFF REVIEW OF EXECUTIVE COMPENSATION DISCLOSURE

In order to facilitate staff review of executive compensation disclosure during the 1994 proxy season, the Commission recently announced in its publication of refinements to the executive compensation requirements [See Rel. No. 33-7032 (November 22, 1993)] that issuers may submit their executive compensation disclosures for staff review prior to filing with the Commission. These submissions should be directed to the attention of John Bernas of the Division of Corporation Finance by mail at Securities Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20549, Mail Stop 3-7 or by facsimile to (202) 272-7546. In order to review the draft, the staff would have to be provided with all of the disclosure required by Items 402 and 404 of Regulation S-K and Item 10 of Schedule 14A at least 20 days before comments are necessary. Issuers should confirm receipt of the materials by calling (202) 272-3097. Issuers submitting the information on EDGAR should use the document tag <CORRESP> which will ensure that the information remains non-public. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ARKANSAS POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Arkansas Power & Light Company (AP&L), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Entergy Corporation, a registered holding company. AP&L is authorized to issue \$270 million of preferred stock, through December 31, 1995, under the exemptive provisions of Rule 52 (Additional Stock). For the period during which any shares of the Additional Stock are outstanding, AP&L is authorized to redeem shares of its Additional Stock, in accordance with any mandatory or optional redemption provisions established at the time of the Additional Stock's initial issuance and redeem (or purchase in lieu of redemption) outstanding Additional Stock, in accordance with the sinking fund provisions established at the time of the Additional Stock's initial issuance. In addition, AP&L may extend its period of authorization through December 31, 1995 to acquire from time to time approximately \$198.82 million aggregate principal amount

of one or more series of AP&L's outstanding first mortgage bonds; \$175 million aggregate principal amount of one or more series of the outstanding pollution control revenue bonds and/or solid waste disposal bonds issued for AP&L's benefit; and \$150 million aggregate par value of one or more series of AP&L's outstanding preferred stock. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Securities Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSTC-93-11) which became effective upon filing. The rule change allows MSTC to accept for deposit securities, which are eligible for deposit at MSTC, in denominations of less than \$1,000. (Rel. 34-33278)

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-92-38) filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange to permit the PSE to increase position and exercise limits for individual equity options and narrow-based stock index options traded on the Exchange. (Rel. 34-33282)

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-93-07) filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange to permit the PHLX to increase position and exercise limits for individual equity options and narrow-based stock index options traded on the Exchange. (Rel. 34-33288)

PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-93-41), on an accelerated basis, filed by the New York Stock Exchange to permit the NYSE to increase position and exercise limits for individual equity options and narrow-based stock index options traded on the Exchange. (Rel. 34-33284)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-43), on an accelerated basis, filed by the Chicago Board Options Exchange to permit the CBOE to increase position and exercise limits for individual equity options and narrow-based stock index options traded on the Exchange. (Rel. 34-33283)

The Commission approved a proposed rule change (SR-AMEX-93-27), on an accelerated basis, filed by the American Stock Exchange to permit the AMEX to increase position and exercise limits for individual equity options and narrow-based stock index options traded on the Exchange. (Rel. 34-33285)

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-93-70) which the Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, to extend the expiration date of the Policy Statement on Market Closings until December 31, 1994. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 13. (Rel. 34-33292)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Chicago Board Options Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-93-48) to establish the following fine schedule for position limit violations which occur in non-CBOE member customer accounts carried by CBOE member firms, including the accounts of non-member broker-dealers: a letter of caution for position limit violations up to 5% in excess of the applicable limit plus \$1 per contract above that level for one to six violations within one calendar year; \$1 per contract over the applicable limit for seven to 12 position limit violations within one calendar year; and \$5 per contract over the applicable limit for 13 or more position limit violations within one calendar year. In calculating the fine thresholds for each CBOE member, all non-member customer account position limit violations occurring within a single calendar year in all of the member's non-member customer accounts will be added together. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of December 15. (Rel. 34-33291)
