NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

CHANGE IN THE MEETING: POSTPONEMENT

The Commission has postponed the open meeting scheduled for Wednesday, February 22, beginning at 10:00. The items will be rescheduled at a later date.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

OPINION ISSUED AGAINST WASHINGTON DOCUMENT SERVICE, INC.

The Commission issued an Opinion and entered an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions on Washington Document Service, Inc. (WDS), a document research and retrieval company which uses the Commission's Public Reference facilities to fill customer orders for copies of documents filed with the Commission. The Commission found that in January 1988 two WDS employees represented to a Commission attorney that they were Commission employees in order to obtain a document that had been filed with the Commission but was not available in the Public Reference Room. In addition, the Commission found that WDS sent the original Commission document to its client. Because of the nature of the conduct and WDS' history of violations of applicable rules and regulations, the Commission barred WDS employees from the Public Reference Room for four weeks. Commissioner Grundfest concurred in the findings but filed a dissent in which he stated that he viewed the sanction as too light. The sanction was scheduled to begin on February 21. The Commission has, however, temporarily stayed its order, during its consideration of an application by WDS for a stay pending appeal to the Court of Appeals. (Rel. 34-26552)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION AGAINST JAMES M. MARKHAM SETTLED

The Commission announced today the settlement of a pending injunctive action against James M. Markham, former director of Industrial Purchasing for Toys R Us Incorporated (TRU). Without admitting or denying the allegations, Markham consented to a Final Judgment permanently enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. Markham also agreed to disgorge profits of approximately \$35,000 and to pay an Insider Trading Sanctions Act penalty of \$10,000.

In its September 26, 1988 Complaint, the Commission alleged that during November and December 1986, Markham obtained material non-public information indicating that TRU's 1986 Christmas season sales would be better than expected. The Commission alleged that Markham purchased TRU options while in possession of such information in violation of an insider's duty either to disclose such information or abstain from trading. Markham sold the options after TRU publicly announced that its 1986 Christmas sales were up approximately 26.8 percent over TRU's 1985 Christmas sales. (SEC v. James M. Markham, USDC DNJ, Civil Action No. 88-4167, AJL Jr.). (LR-12003)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MERRILL LYNCH INSTITUTIONAL FUND

An exemptive order amending a prior order dated May 24, 1984 [Rel. IC-13962] has been issued on an application filed by Merrill Lynch Institutional Fund, et al. (Applicants) declaring that Charles C. Cabot, Jr., a director/trustee of Applicants, shall not be deemed an "interested person" of the Funds within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Act. (Rel. IC-16817 - Feb. 17)

MUTUAL BEACON FUND, INC.; MUTUAL QUALIFIED INCOME FUND INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until March 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Mutual Beacon Fund, Inc.; and Mutual Qualified Income Fund Inc. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-16818; IC-16819 - Feb. 17)
