CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTION AND ORDER OF DISGORGEMENT ENTERED AGAINST FRANK R. BREITWEISER

The New York Regional Office filed a Civil Complaint on March 23 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York charging Frank R. Breitweiser, a registered investment adviser doing business as Orange County Financial Planning Services, Inc., with violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and the record-keeping provisions of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, and seeking disgorgement of \$151,139.

The Complaint alleged Breitweiser made material misstatements and omissions of material facts in the offer and sale and in connection with the purchase and sale of securities in two investment clubs. Most notably, Breitweiser misrepresented the risk, value, liquidity, rate of return of the securities, and the use of proceeds from the securities offerings. Breitweiser also failed to disclose that he borrowed \$111,019 from one investment club at a below market interest rate. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaint, Breitweiser consented to a Final Judgment permanently enjoining him from the above described violations and an Order that he disgorge \$151,139. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THOMAS J. HERZFELD ADVISORS (CANADA) INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 24 to request a hearing on an application filed by Thomas J. Herzfeld Advisors (Canada), Inc., on behalf of T. J. Herzfeld Discount Asset Fund, for an order conditionally exempting it from the provisions of Section 12(d)(1)(A) of the Investment Company Act to permit the Fund, an unregistered Canadian closed-end fund holding company, to invest in the securities of United States registered closed-end investment companies. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE POTOMAC EDISON COMPANY; AEP GENERATING COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until April 24 to request a hearing on proposals by the following companies filed under Release 35, 24849, dated March 30: THE POTOMAC EDISON COMPANY - subsidiary of Allegheny Power System, Inc., to incur short-term debt in an aggregate principal amount of \$72 million, from time to time through March 31, 1991; AEP GENERATING COMPANY (AEGCo) and INDIANA MICHIGAN POWER COMPANY - subsidiaries of American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), for each to sell and leaseback their respective 50% undivided ownership interests in Rockport Generating Station Unit No. 2. The aggregate fair market value is estimated not to exceed \$1.7 billion. It is proposed that the aggregate cost will be provided by both equity investors and debt financing. In addition, AEP will waive certain rights it may have under certain sections of the Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1978 should an AEGCo bankruptcy occur. AEGCo requests authorization to pay a dividend to AEP from its Other Paid-In Capital account in order to maintain long-term debt and common equity ratios of approximately 65% and 35%, respectively.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-45) that establishes fees for processing new member organization, non-public floor professional and option trading right holder applications and the applications of persons subject to a statutory disqualification under Section 3(a)(39) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
