CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST RICK N. HANSEN

The Denver Regional and Salt Lake City Branch Offices filed a Complaint on April 4 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Utah seeking injunctive relief against Rick N. Hansen of Salt Lake City. Hansen consented to a permanent injunction which prohibits him from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Complaint alleges that Hansen purchased and resold two shell corporations, Protecto Industries, Inc. and Consolidated Funding Services, Inc. Hansen allegedly violated the antifraud provisions through, among other things, his preparation and dissemination of disclosure materials for the corporations. These materials failed to disclose that the claims of the corporations to exemption from registration for their securities were based on fabricated shareholders lists. Hansen also allegedly violated the registration provisions in a scheme to offer the unregistered securities of Protecto and Consolidated to the public. (SEC v. Rick N. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NOMURA MORTGAGE CAPITAL CORPORATION

A conditional order has been issued granting Nomura Mortgage Capital Corporation an exemption from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and the sale of residual interests. (Rel. IC-16941 - Apr. 28)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued releasing jurisdiction over certain aspects of a proposal by National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Enerop Corporation. Under the proposal, National was authorized to assign its interests in Metscan, Inc. to Enerop, and to make a capital contribution to Enerop of up to \$442,500. Enerop used such funds to invest in Metscan Technology Partners, a partnership formed by Metscan, which develops and markets certain gas meter reading technology. Jurisdiction has been released over the conversion of Enerop's entire partnership interest into an equity interest in a corporation formed from the partnership. (Rel. 35-24874 - Apr. 27)

COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$200 million of its medium-term notes with maturities of up to 30 years, pursuant to a deviation from the Commission's Statement of Policy Regarding First Mortgage Bonds Subject to the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 regarding sinking fund requirements. (Rel. 35-24875 - Apr. 27)

MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 22 to request a hearing on a proposal by Massachusetts Electric Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to issue and sell up to \$100 million of its medium-term notes with maturities ranging from nine months to 30 years, pursuant to an exemption from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50(a)(5) and a deviation from the Commission's Statement of Policy Regarding First Mortgage Bonds Subject to the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 regarding sinking fund, redemption, and dividend requirements. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
