COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

FRIEND-OF-THE-COURT BRIEF FILED

Daniel L. Goelzer, General Counsel of the Commission, announced today that the Commission filed in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit a friend-of-the court brief in Foremost Guaranty Corporation v. Meritor Savings Bank and EPIC Mortgage Inc., et al. The brief addresses the question whether certain mortgage backed pass-through certificates issued as part of a comprehensive real estate investment program structured by Equity Programs Investment Corporation and affiliated companies are securities. The district court held that the certificates were not securities in the form of "investment contracts." The Commission's brief argues that the certificates are securities within the statutory definitional terms "instrument commonly known as a 'security,'" "investment contract," and "certificate of interest * * * in any profit-sharing agreement" in the Securities Act and the Securities Exchange Act. Further, the brief states that affirmation of the district court's unprecedented holding that these certificates -- similar to mortgage backed certificates, representing billions of dollars in pooled mortgage loans, sold in primary and secondary markets -- are not securities, will have a disruptive effect on the financial markets and deprive the many purchasers of such instruments of protections of the securities laws. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST WALTER F. KUSAY, JR.

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on May 17 Judge Brian Barnett Duff, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, entered a Temporary Restraining Order against Walter F. Kusay, Jr. The Order temporarily restrains and enjoins Kusay from violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. It also freezes all of Kusay's assets, requires the production of documents, prohibits the destruction of books and records, and requires Kusay to provide an accounting to the Court.

The Complaint alleged that Kusay misused \$1.5 million of customer funds given to him for investment purposes. (SEC v. Walter F. Kusay, Jr., NDIL, E. Div., Civil Action No. 89C4000). (LR-12114)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

PIPER JAFFRAY INVESTMENT TRUST INC.

An order has been issued permitting Piper Jaffray Investment Trust Inc., American Government Income Portfolio, Inc., and American Government Term Trust Inc. (Funds), and Piper Capital Management Incorporated to deposit uninvested cash balances of the Funds into a single joint account to be used to enter into large repurchase agreements. (Rel. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 26 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, including Granite State Electric Company, Massachusetts Electric Company (Mass Electric), The Narragansett Electric Company, NEES Energy, Incorporated, New England Electric Transmission Corporation, New England Energy Incorporated, New England Hydro-Transmission Electric Company, Inc., New England Hydro-Transmission Corporation, New England Power Company, and New England Power Service Company, whereby Mass Electric seeks separate authority to increase, from \$75 million to \$110 million outstanding at any one time, its existing authority to issue short-term notes to the NEES Money Pool and/or banks and to issue and sell commercial paper through October 31, 1990, and the members of the Money Pool seek authority to acquire such notes. Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Philadelphia Depository Trust Company (SR-PHILADEP-89-2) requesting approval of enhancements to its PHILANET Terminal Communication System (PTCS) and requesting the Commission to authorize PTCS to operate on a permanent basis. (Rel. 34-26872); The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-89-5) that would increase capital requirements for specialist posts and competing and alternate specialists.
