COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER AFFIRMING FOIA OFFICER'S DETERMINATION

The General Counsel sent a letter to Jay L. Panzarella, Esq., affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to withhold in their entirety brokerage account statements submitted by a complainant to the Commission's Office of Consumer Affairs and Information Services. The General Counsel relied on FOIA Exemption 6, 5 USC 552(b)(6), and concluded that release that complainant's brokerage statements would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Moreover, under the circumstances of this request, redaction of identifying information from the statements would not be sufficient to protect the complainant's privacy. (Rel. FOIA-113)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES INFORMATION SOLUTIONS, INC.

The Denver Regional Office filed a Complaint for Injunction and Other Equitable Relief on May 19 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado against Information Solutions, Inc. (ISI), of Englewood, Colorado, and two of its officers, David R. DeYoung, president, and Mary Anne Mayer, vice president for finance and administration. The Complaint alleges that ISI and Mayer violated the antifraud and internal controls provisions of the securities laws and that all three defendants violated the books and records and reporting provisions of the securities laws in that, among other things, ISI filed periodic reports with the Commission for certain fiscal periods during 1985 through 1986 that misstated the amounts of revenue legitimately earned by the company during those time periods. Specifically, the Complaint alleges that in 1986 Mayer caused ISI to prematurely recognize revenue contrary to its established, internal revenue recognition policy.

Simultaneously each defendant, without admitting or denying the Complaint's allegations, filed consents in which they each consent to a Final Order of Permanent Injunction. These consents were presented to the Court for its consideration. (SEC v. Information Solutions, Inc., USDC CO, Civil Action No. 89-2-874). (LR-12119)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ENTERED AGAINST LEONARD MEYERS

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices filed a civil injunctive action on May 26 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida against Leonard Meyers of Palm Beach County, Florida. The Commission seeks a temporary restraining order, disgorgement, and other equitable relief based upon alleged violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer provisions of the securities laws.

The Complaint alleges that since at least May 1985, Meyers has acted as an unregistered broker-dealer. Further, since at least May 1987, Meyers has defrauded at least 12 investors of \$245,000 by misrepresenting that their funds would be invested in shares of mutual funds when Meyers actually converted the investors' funds to his own use. Meyers concealed his fraud by providing to investors phony account statements, memoranda, and forged letters on Commission letterhead.

On May 31, Judge Jose A. Gonzalez Jr. entered a temporary restraining order restraining further violations of the antifraud and broker-dealer registration provisions, freezing Meyers' assets, and setting a June 8, 1989 hearing on the Commission's application for a preliminary injunction. (SEC v. Leonard Meyers, USDC SCFL, Civil Action No. 89-8244-CIV-Gonzalez, filed May 26, 1989). (LR-12120)

WILLIAM H. BARTLETT, MICHIGAN DAIRY SERVICES ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on May 30 Judge Suzanne B. Conlon, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, granted the Commission's Motion For An Order To Show Cause Why William H. Bartlett and Michigan Dairy Services Should Not Be Adjudged in Civil Contempt. A hearing on this matter was set for June 7.

On March 1, Bartlett and Michigan Dairy were permanently enjoined, pursuant to their consent without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's Complaint, from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Additionally, Bartlett and Michigan Dairy were ordered to provide accountings concerning the amount received from their fraudulent sale of unregistered securities, the use of proceeds, and the amount and location of any remaining funds. The Commission alleged that the accounting provided by Bartlett, on behalf of Michigan Dairy, was inadequate in several material respects. Among other things, the accounting failed to specify adequately the use of proceeds. The failure to provide an adequate accounting was the subject of the June 7th show cause hearing. (SEC v. William H. Bartlett, et al., NDIL, Civil Action No. 89-C-1648, filed February 28, 1989). (LR-12121)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

NORMAN VANCE INDICTED

The Los Angeles Regional Office and the United States Attorney for the District of New Mexico announced that on June 1 an indictment against Norman Vance was unsealed. The indictment was originally filed on May 26. In the two-count indictment, Vance was charged with violating 18 USC § 1623 (making a false declaration before a grand jury). It was alleged that Vance's false testimony was material to the Grand Jury's investigation of mail fraud, wire fraud, and securities violations in the purchase of stock in Radtech, Inc., through nominee accounts, with \$500,000 in cash. (U.S. v. Norman Vance, CR 89-220, DNM). (LR-12122)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BENHAM GOVERNMENT INCOME TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by Benham Government Income Trust, Benham Equity Funds, Benham Variable Insurance Trust, Benham California Tax-Free Trust, Benham National Tax-Free Trust, and Capital Preservation Fund for an order permitting certain affiliated transactions involving investment company shares. (Rel. IC-16981 - June 5)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing American Electric Power Company, Inc. (AEP), a registered holding company, and a proposed subsidiary, AEP Resources, Inc. (AEP Resources) to engage in the investment and participation in qualifying cogeneration facilities and in qualifying small power production facilities. AEP and AEP Resources propose for AEP Resources to issue and AEP to acquire 100 shares of common stock of AEP Resources for \$10,000. AEP proposes to invest up to an aggregate amount of \$7.5 million in AEP Resources for each of four years in the period ending December 31, 1992. (Rel. 35-24898 - June 6)

AMENDMENT OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed an amendment to a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-89-1) setting forth its detailed procedures concerning its proposal to eliminate most Certificate-on-Demand urgent withdrawals of corporate issues settling in next-day funds that are not full Fast Automated Securities Transfer issues and to institute a new rush transfer service for those issues.
