TRADING SUSPENSIONS

TRADING SUSPENSION IN LIFELINE HEALTHCARE GROUP, LTD.

The Commission announced the temporary suspension of trading in the securities of Lifeline Healthcare Group, Ltd., a Delaware corporation with executive offices in Broken Arrow, Oklahoma, for a single ten-day period which began at 9:30 a.m. (EDT) on July 26 and will terminate at 11:59 p.m. (EDT) on August 4.

The Commission temporarily suspended trading in Lifeline's securities because of questions about recent market activity in its securities and the adequacy and accuracy of publicly disseminated information concerning the valuation of its assets, the results of its business operations, recent acquisitions announced by it, the identity of certain owners of five percent or more of its stock, and the nature and terms of the distribution of a stock dividend authorized by it on April 8.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

PROMOTERS OF INVENTION PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on July 11 the U.S. District Court for the District of Kansas entered orders of permanent injunction against ZETEX, LTD., a Cayman Island Corporation; Western States Production Company, Inc., a Texas corporation; Equigroup Securities, Inc., a Texas corporation doing business in Littleton, Colorado; Joseph D. Gordon of Grand Prairie, Texas; and Roger N. Arnold of Westlake Village, California. Defendants are permanently enjoined from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Equigroup and Arnold are also enjoined from violating the broker-dealer fraud provisions. Defendants consented to the orders without admitting or denying the allegations.

The Complaint alleges that defendants engaged in the fraudulent offer and sales of unregistered common stock of three issuers, each of which purportedly owned the rights to a "revolutionary" concept of electromagnetic propulsion. It also alleges that much of the information disclosed to investors was false and misleading concerning, among other things, the development of the invention; the authenticity, tradeability, and value of stock; the securities law enforcement history of officers, directors, and control persons of the issuers; and the use of proceeds of the securities offerings. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

ARTHUR PACKARD CONDIE AND ARTHUR R. CONDIE INDICTED

The U.S. Attorney for the District of Nevada, the Los Angeles Regional Office, and the Internal Revenue Service announced that on July 18 a federal grand jury sitting in Las Vegas, Nevada, returned a ten-count indictment against Arthur Packard Condie and his son, Arthur R. Condie. The indictment charges them with conspiring to violate the securities laws and avoid the currency transaction reporting requirements; securities fraud; structuring currency transactions to avoid the reporting requirements; and interstate travel in aid of a racketeering enterprise. The indictment also charges that the Condie's were part of a scheme involving sham "blind pool" and "blank check" public securities offerings of PBS Development Corporation and Adiron, Inc. wherein all the shares purportedly offered to the public were, in fact, purchased by alleged co-conspirator Michael Wright through the use of nominees. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

RYAN MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION V

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Ryan Mortgage Acceptance Corporation V for a conditional order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act in connection with the issuance of collateralized mortgage obligations and the sale of certain residual interests.
