ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

EDWARD GRUSHKO BARRED

The Commission instituted administrative proceedings under Rule 2(e) of its Rules of Practice against Edward Grushko, a New York City, New York attorney. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Grushko's Offer of Settlement. The Order finds that Grushko was permanently enjoined from violating or aiding and abetting violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5, 12b-20, 15d-1, 15d-11, and 15d-13. The Order further finds that the underlying Complaint alleges that Grushko, as counsel to GSS Venture Capital Corp. and Green Mountain Venture Corp., two blind pool issuers, filed Forms 10-K, 10-Q, and 8-K which contained numerous misstatements concerning the true identity of persons in control, the issuer's capitalization, the true nature of the issuer's transactions, and changes in the officers and directors of the issuers.

The Order denies Grushko the privilege of practicing before the Commission for three years and, for two years thereafter, limits his practice to acting in the capacity of co-counsel where such other co-counsel is an independent securities lawyer. Additionally, the Order requires Grushko to complete specified continuing legal education. (Rel. 34-27253)

NASD ACTION AGAINST W.C.W. WESTERN CANADA WATER ENTERPRISES DISMISSED AS MOOT

The Commission dismissed a petition filed by W.C.W. Western Canada Water Enterprises, Inc., of Vancouver, Canada, for review of the NASD's denial of its application for initial inclusion of its common stock on the NASD's Automated Quotation System (NASDAQ). The NASD found that WCW failed to satisfy NASDAQ's minimum asset requirement. Shortly after its appeal was filed, WCW qualified for inclusion on NASDAQ, on which its shares are now traded. The Commission concluded that, in light of the fact WCW is now listed on NASDAQ, its appeal should be dismissed as moot. (Rel. 34-27254)

**MOTION OF BACARDI CORPORATION
TO EXPAND SCOPE OF HEARING DENIED**

The Commission denied the motion of Bacardi Corporation to expand the scope of hearings pending before an administrative law judge. The hearings are being held on Bacardi's request to terminate the registration of its common stock under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 on the basis of its claim that its shareholders number less than 300, the statutory basis for deregistration.

The Commission had limited the inquiry to a determination of whether Bacardi's records listed 300 or more shareholders. Bacardi sought to challenge the shareholder status of certain shareholder trusts on the grounds that the trusts were not validly created, that Bacardi was improperly denied information regarding them, and that the trusts were created and stock issued to them merely to circumvent Bacardi's deregistration.

The Commission ruled that the matters raised by Bacardi were not relevant in determining Bacardi's shareholders of record. It stressed the fact that the issue of the trusts' validity was one of local law, and that the Exchange Act's concern with "circumvention" was limited to a company's attempts to avoid registration, not efforts by others to maintain it. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BIRR, WILSON MONEY FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 16 to request a hearing on an application filed by Birr, Wilson Money Fund for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-17143 - Sept. 20)

SEI LIQUID ASSET TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 16 to request a hearing on an application for an order granting exemptions from Sections 18(f), 18(g), and 18(i) of the Investment Company Act to permit SEI Liquid Asset Trust, SEI Tax Exempt Trust, SEI Cash+Plus Trust, SEI Index Funds, SEI Institutional Managed Trust (each a Trust), SEI Financial Management Corporation (SFM), SEI Financial Services Company (SFS), and all other similar investment companies managed and distributed in the future by SFM and SFS (collectively, Applicants) to issue and sell two classes of shares representing interests in some or all of each Trust's existing and future investment portfolios. The classes of shares would be identical in all respects except for differences related to the distribution expenses and/or support services expenses, and the related class designation, voting rights, and dividend payment differences. (Rel. IC-17144 - Sept. 20)
