COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

TO ALL BROKER-DEALERS REGISTERED WITH THE SEC. Failure to keep your Form BD current and to file accurate financial statements on a timely basis and the failure to keep accurate and current books and records or otherwise to comply with the provisions of law applying to the conduct of your business would violate the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. This may result in disciplinary action by a self-regulatory organization and administrative or injunctive action by the Commission or criminal prosecution by the Department of Justice.

SECURITIES ACT REGISTRATIONS

AUTOMATED OPTICS, INC., 6 Dunton Court, East Northport, N.Y. 11731, filed a registration statement on August 31 seeking registration of 250,000 shares of common stock, to be offered for public sale (*at \$10 per share maximum) through underwriters headed by J.H. Kern & Co., 40 Wall St., New York 10005. The company was organized in July to manufacture and sell soft and hard contact lenses and a patented hydrophilic plastic material to be used in making soft lenses. Part of the net proceeds of the company's stock sale will be paid to purchase the patent rights on the soft lens material and the balance for working capital and other corporate purposes.
