#### COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

#### COMMISSION RELEASES STAFF REPORT ON NATIONWIDE EXAMINATION OF PENNY STOCK BROKER-DEALERS

The Commission issued a Staff Report on February 8 detailing results of 188 examinations of penny stock firms subject to Rule 15c2-6 conducted between March 19 and May 1, 1990 by the Commission, the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. and the State of Florida's Comptroller's Office. The purpose of the examinations was to determine if broker-dealers were complying with the investor protection provisions and recordkeeping requirements of Rule 15c2-6 since the Commission's new rule and Florida's parallel rule went into effect on January 1, 1990.

The Commission adopted Rule 15c2-6 in response to the widespread incidence of fraud and misconduct by broker-dealers engaged in broad scale cold calling for the purpose of selling certain penny stocks to members of the public. These examinations were conducted as part of the Commission's continuing efforts against penny stock fraud. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION CONTACT: Mark D. Fitterman (202)272-2830, Joseph I. #### CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

#### FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISGORGEMENT ENTERED AGAINST WILLIAM MULDERIG

On February 1, the Los Angeles Regional Office announced that U.S. District Judge Thomas Penfield Jackson entered a Final Judgment of Disgorgement against defendant William M. Mulderig granting the Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment of Disgorgement. The Final Judgment orders Mulderig to pay \$1,625,000 in disgorgement and \$585,338.86 in prejudgment interest.

On October 19, 1989, Mulderig was permanently enjoined from, among other things, violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. It was uncontroverted that he had conducted a fraudulent publicity campaign, making misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning the effectiveness of a "sober pill" that was represented to reduce blood alcohol levels, making a drunk person sober, with the intention of influencing the price of Unioil stock. Following the publicity campaign and a rise in the price of Unioil stock, on

December 12, 1986, Mulderig exercised a previously acquired option to buy 3,000,000 shares of Unioil stock. Mulderig purchased the shares for \$0.25 per share pursuant to the option agreement when the stock was being sold on the Boston Stock Exchange for \$1 3/16 per share. The disgorgement amount reflects the difference between the Exchange price, discounted by one-third because the shares were restricted and Mulderig's purchase price. [SEC v. Unioil and William M. #### HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

#### CNG TRANSMISSION CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 27 to request a hearing on a proposal by CNG Transmission Corporation (Transmission), a wholly owned gas pipeline subsidiary of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, and CNG Iroquois, Inc. (CNGI), a wholly owned subsidiary of Transmission, whereby CNGI will acquire an additional 3% partnership interest in the Iroquois Gas Transmission System L.P. (Iroquois) from ANR Iroquois, Inc. (ANR). Authorization is also sought through June 30, 1993 for: (1) CNGI to make up to \$13 million in additional equity contributions to Iroquois, with CNGI's total contributions limited to \$25 million; (2) CNGI to issue and sell to Transmission up to 1,300 additional shares of CNGI common stock (\$10,000 par value, total purchase price of \$13 million), which CNGI may occasionally purchase from Transmission, hold as treasury shares and resell to Transmission; and (3) Transmission to make open account advances to CNGI, which, together with the common stock, will aggregate a maximum of \$25 million, and provide guarantees and indemnities on CNGI's behalf up to \$25 million at any one time. An initial notice was issued on February 1 (HCAR No. 25250) regarding a proposal by CNGI to acquire the additional 3% interest in Iroquois from Texas Eastern Iroquois, Inc., rather than ANR, and related transactions. #### SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE AND ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved a proposed rule change by the <u>Cincinnati Stock Exchange</u> (SR-CSE-90-6) submitted on March 23, 1990, pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act, 15 U.S.C. 78s(b)(1), and Rule 19b-4 thereunder, and has granted accelerated approval of an amendment (Amendment No. 1) thereto, submitted on November 14, 1990, for a six month pilot period from the date of this order. The proposed rule change modifies the CSE's time priority rules to permit a market maker to act as Dealer of the Day and thus have priority over same-priced market maker or professional agency interest entered prior in time to his or her bid or offer when the market maker is interacting with the public agency market and marketable limit orders that he or she represents as agent. Amendment No. 1 provides amendments to be made to the rule filing regarding: (1) short-sale arbitrage programs; (2) payment for order flow; (3) limitation on number of issues in which a Designated Dealer can preference during the period of the pilot; and (4) length of service as dealer. Publication of the release in the <u>Federal Register</u> is expected during the week of February 11. (Rel. 34-28866)

#### PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The <u>Midwest Stock Exchange</u> filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSE-91-4) pursuant to Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to revise its odd-lot pricing procedures. The MSE proposes to amend Article XXXI, Rule 9(c)(iv) and (v) in order to allow "buy" and "sell" odd-lot limit orders to be executed at the limit price after there has been a full lot transaction in the primary market at the limit price. Publication of the proposal is expected in the <u>Federal Register</u> during the week of February 11. (Rel. 34-28868)
