CIVIL ACTION FILED AGAINST DAVID STERNS AND OTHERS

On March 11, the Commission announced the filing of a civil action in California against David D. Sterns, Verl V. Sterns II, Mark A. Sterns, Jonathan D. Sterns, J. Marcus Ryan, Debra A. Sterns, Fountain Industries, Inc., Lee R. Shrout, Martha M. Kreider, James F. Morphew, Swiss Pacific Group, S.A., Joseph P. Cillo, David N. Gliksman, Norman L. Dixon, Acrotech, Inc., Advanced Technical Systems, Inc., Ameritex, Inc., Ayin Corporation, Gentre Industries, Inc., OmniSource, Inc., Barry L. Gilliam, David R. High, Primeritexx, Inc., and the Huntor Group, alleging, variously, that the defendants violated Sections 5 and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

As part of its action, the Commission is seeking a Temporary Restraining Order enjoining the Huntor Group and David Sterns from further violations of the federal securities laws and is also seeking an Order Freezing Assets of the Huntor Group and David Sterns.

In addition, the Commission seeks permanent relief against all of the defendants, including injunctions against future violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws, restitution to defrauded investors, and, as to David Sterns, the maximum penalties available pursuant to the Securities Enforcement Remedies and Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990. PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-91-05) to standardize certain

listing requirements for securities other than common stocks and bonds (Rel. 34-28944); National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-91-12) concerning the OTC Bulletin Board Service requiring that all quotations for non-foreign issues entered into the system be firm (Rel. 34-28946); and National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-91-4) to amend Section C under Part IX of Schedule D to the NASD By-Laws to expand service offerings and establish subscriber fees for receipt of broadcast feeds of NASDAQ/National Market System last sale data or National Quotation Data Service quotation information (Rel. 34-28947). Publication of the proposals is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 11.

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
