## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday mornings. Meetings on Wednesdays, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. ### OPEN MEETING - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 3, 1991 - 10:00 A.M.

The subject matter of the April 3rd open meeting will be:

1. Consideration of whether to propose for public comment rules implementing sections of the Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990. The proposed rules will define the term "penny stock" under the Act; provide certain transactional exemptions from the proposed rules; require broker-dealer distribution of a risk disclosure document; require the disclosure of bid and offer quotations; require the disclosure of broker-dealer and associated person compensation; require monthly account statements; and require the disclosure of sole market maker status. 2. Consideration of whether to adopt amendments to Rule 15c2-11 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The amendments relate, among other things, to the rule's information gathering and review requirement and are intended to clarify and enhance the degree of scrutiny a broker-dealer must give to the specified information.

Also, the Commission will consider whether to propose further amendments to Rule 15c2-11. The proposed amendments, among other things, would substantially narrow the scope of the "piggyback exception" and would encourage the creation of one or more central information repositories. #### INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

##### TEMPLETON AMERICAN TRUST

An order has been issued under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act on an application filed by Templeton American Trust, Inc. (formerly Templeton American Growth Trust, Inc.) and Templeton Funds Distributor, Inc. granting an exemption from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to permit the imposition and waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge. (Rel. IC-18062 - March 26)

##### THOMSON FUND GROUP

A conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act has been issued on an application filed by Thomson Fund Group. The order grants an exemption from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit applicant to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. ##### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed by the following under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act: Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-91-07) to list and trade reduced value options on the Financial Times-Stock Exchange 100 Index (Rel. 34-29004); American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-33) to amend the stock price maintenance

requirements for the continued listing of options on certain low-priced equity securities (Rel. 34-29005); and Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-91-02) to amend the clearinghouse agreement and a corresponding letter agreement, both dated August 20, 1987, between OCC and Associate Clearing House Amsterdam B.V. (ACHA) to increase ACHA's capital requirements, provide OCC with additional early-warning mechanisms concerning ACHA's capital and obligate ACHA to maintain an overdraft facility (Rel. 34-29007). Publication of the notices is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 25.

#### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change submitted by the American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-91-03), which eliminates the requirement that the AMEX halt trading in broad-based index options after the Standard and Poor's 500 Index futures contract has declined 30 points from its closing value on the previous day. Publication of the approval order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 25. (Rel. 34-29006)
