## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON BROKERAGE FIRM AND PRINCIPALS NAMED AND PENALTIES SOUGHT

The Seattle Regional Office of the Commission announced that on April 22 a complaint was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington against Kochcapital, Inc., a Bellevue, Washington broker-dealer, Russell G. Koch, its president, and Donald W. Jones, its compliance officer. The complaint alleges that Kochcapital, aided and abetted by Koch and Jones, violated Section 15(c)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 15c2-6 thereunder in more than 800 transactions involving approximately \$4 million. The Commission is seeking an injunction, an accounting and an offer of rescission to all customers involved in violative trades. The Commission is also seeking penalties against all defendants for violations after October 15, 1990 in the first non-fraud case by the Commission seeking that relief. [SEC v. ## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### DREYFUS INVESTMENT GRADE MUNICIPAL FUND PATRIOT GROUP INVESTMENT TRUST

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that DREYFUS INVESTMENT GRADE MUNICIPAL FUND, INC. and PATRIOT GROUP INVESTMENT TRUST have ceased to be investment companies. (Refs. IC-18115 and IC-18116, respectively - April 26)

### MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 21 to request a hearing on an application. The application is filed by Monarch Life Insurance Company, First Variable Life Insurance Company, Variable Account A of Monarch Life Insurance Company, Variable Account B of Monarch Life Insurance Company, Variable Account A1 of Monarch Life Insurance Company, Variable Account B1 of Monarch Life Insurance Company, The Fidelity Variable Account of Monarch Life Insurance Company, Separate Account VA-1 of Monarch Life Insurance Company, Separate Account VA of Monarch Life Insurance Company, First Variable Life Insurance Company Fund E, Monarch Financial Services, Inc., and Monarch Services, Inc. The application is for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act to amend existing orders of exemption (Existing Orders) under Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 12(d)(1), 22(c), 26(a)(2), 27(a)(1), 27(a)(3), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(d), 27(f), and 27(h)(3) of the Act and Rules 6e-2 and 22c-1 thereunder. The amendments would (i) add MSI as a party to the exemptive relief previously granted in each Existing Order; and (ii) specify that MSI acts as a principal underwriter with respect to the variable life insurance policies and variable annuity contracts described in the Existing Orders. ### BAILLIE GIFFORD INTERNATIONAL FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 23 to request a hearing on an application filed by Baillie Gifford International Fund, Inc. for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order would exempt applicant from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit it to invest in equity or convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. (IC-18118; International Series Rel. 263 - April 26)

### DEAN WITTER REYNOLDS

A conditional order has been issued pursuant to Section 9(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting Dean Witter Reynolds Inc. (Dean Witter) from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act. The conditional order would relieve Dean Witter from any ineligibility resulting from the employment of three individuals who have been enjoined from engaging in certain securities- or commodities-related conduct. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by Southwestern Electric Power Company (SWEPCO), an electric public utility subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation (CSW), a registered holding company. It is proposed that SWEPCO enter into an agreement to amend an existing \$50 million loan agreement between SWEPCO and three banks to (1) extend the maturity of the loan through June 15, 1997; (2) amend the interest rate on the loan; (3) add provisions to compensate the lenders for their costs of complying with capital adequacy regulations; and (4) add assignment and participation provisions. ### ALLEGHENY GENERATING COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 20 to request a hearing on a proposal by Allegheny Generating Company (AGC), an electric public-utility subsidiary company of Monongahela Power Company (Monongahela), The Potomac Edison Company (Potomac Edison) and West Penn Power Company (West Penn). Each is a electric public-utility subsidiary company of Allegheny Power System, Inc., a registered holding company. According to the proposal, AGC will issue promissory notes up to a maximum aggregate principal amount of \$150 million, through June 30, 1993, pursuant to a revolving credit agreement (Agreement) with a group of nine banks. Monongahela, Potomac Edison and West Penn, severally and not jointly, propose to guarantee 27%, 28% and 45%, respectively, of the amount due the banks from AGC under the Agreement. (Rel. 35-25303)

### GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION
