APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has approved proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act by the following: Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-90-35) to amend its arbitration rules and procedures (Rel. 34-29151); and American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-90-16) to conform Amex's post-trade processing rules to the requirements of Amex's Intra-Day Comparison System. PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The New York Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-NYSE-91-09) under Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to add two enhancements to the NYSE's Overnight Comparison System. The two enhancements would permit the use of NYSE's Step-Out Service to automate step-out trades and permit the automated comparison of cash trades.
