COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ORDER AFFIRMING DENIAL OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

On April 29, the General Counsel of the Commission sent a letter to David Bendah, in response to his appeal under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), affirming the FOIA Officer's determination to deny access to certain information pursuant to FOIA Exemption 7(A), 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(A). (FOIA Rel. 172)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ADVISORS INTERNATIONAL FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 31 to request a hearing on an application filed by Advisors International Fund (Applicant) for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order would exempt Applicant from the provisions of Section 12(d)(3) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 12d3-1 thereunder. Applicant would be exempted to the extent necessary to permit it to invest in equity securities and convertible debt securities issued by foreign issuers that derived more than 15% of their gross revenues from their activities as a broker, dealer, underwriter, or investment adviser, provided such investments meet the conditions described in proposed amended Rule 12d3-1. MAS POOLED TRUST FUND AND MILLER ANDERSON & SHERRERD

A conditional order has been issued under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder on an application filed by MAS Pooled Trust Fund (Fund), Miller Anderson & Sherrerd (Adviser) and all future portfolios of the Fund advised by the Adviser. The order permits the Fund's portfolios to pool their daily uninvested cash balances into a joint account for the purpose of entering into one or more repurchase agreements. (Rel. IC-18135 - May 6)

CONVERTIBLE HOLDINGS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by Convertible Holdings, Inc. (Applicant) for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order would exempt Applicant from the provisions of Section 18(a)(2)(B) of the Act to permit it to purchase its shares on a securities exchange. (Rel. IC-18136 - May 6)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
