## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

### PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE COMMISSION'S PROXY RULES UNDER SECTION 14(a)

The Commission released today for public comment proposed amendments to the Commission's proxy rules under Section 14(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 that would facilitate securityholder communications in furtherance of informed proxy voting decisions by securityholders, and reduce the costs of compliance with the proxy rules for all persons engaged in a proxy solicitation, by (1) exempting from all proxy rules but the antifraud provisions any solicitation by "disinterested persons," or persons who have no material economic interest in the solicitation and who do not seek authority to act as a proxy for securityholders; (2) limiting the types of proxy soliciting material required to be filed in preliminary form to the proxy statement and form of proxy; (3) eliminating the non-public treatment of preliminary proxy materials; and (4) requiring the registrant to deliver a list of record and beneficial holders to a requesting securityholder under specified circumstances. ### PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO FORM S-4 AND F-4, REGULATION S-K, AND RULES 14a-6, 14c-2 AND 14e-1; AND INTERPRETIVE RELEASE CONCERNING ROLL-UP TRANSACTIONS AND LIMITED PARTNERSHIP OFFERINGS

The Commission is publishing for comment today proposed rules that provide additional disclosure requirements for limited partnership roll-up transactions and that would set a minimum solicitation period for roll-up transactions. These changes would improve the quality and readability of information provided to investors in connection with limited partnership roll-up transactions. (Rels. 33-6899; 34-29313; File No. S7-21-91)

Also, the Commission is publishing today a release setting forth interpretive views of existing disclosure requirements applicable to limited partnership roll-up transactions and initial public offerings of limited partnership units. These interpretations are effective today, June 17, 1991. (Rels. 33-6900; 34-29314)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### COMPLAINT AGAINST NPS TECHNOLOGIES GROUP

The Commission announced that it filed a complaint today in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction (Judgment) against NPS Technologies Group, Inc. (NPS) of 25 Chobot Lane, Elmwood Park, New Jersey 07414. The Commission is seeking to compel NPS to file its delinquent reports and to enjoin it from further violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-25, 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder. Simultaneously with the filing of the Commission's complaint NPS consented to the entry of a Final Judgment. In its Consent, NPS admitted that it had failed to file thirteen periodic reports and fourteen Notifications of Late Filing, and that it had filed late two amended periodic reports. [SEC v. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

---

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 by the following: Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-91-08) relating to a new legal notice system (Rel. 34-29291); and Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-90-3) amending Rule G-36 to require underwriters to deliver advance refunding documents to the MSRB (Rel. 34-29299). Publication of the orders is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 17.

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-90-2) that permits the MSRB to establish and operate a central electronic facility, the Municipal Securities Information Library, through which information regarding municipal securities and their issuers would be made available to market participants and information vendors. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 17. (Rel. 34-29298)

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Depository Trust Company filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-91-13) under Rule 19b-4 that would allow DTC to expand the use of its Segregation Account #100 (Seg-100 Account). Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 17. (Rel. 34-29296)

## ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission has granted accelerated approval for a temporary period ending on May 24, 1993 of a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-91-26) to adopt a new Rule 232. The rule change will require PHLX specialists to provide primary market protection for limit orders that are entered during PHLX's primary trading session and designated as executable after the PHLX close. (Rel. 34-29300)

The Commission has granted accelerated approval for a temporary period ending on May 24, 1993 of a proposed rule change and Amendments No. 1 and 2 filed by the Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-91-4) to add a new Chapter IIB, Facilitation of GTX Orders, to the Exchange's Rules of the Board of Governors. The rule change will require BSE specialists to provide primary market protection for limit orders, designated as executable after the BSE close, based on volume that prints in the primary market's after-hours session. (Rel. 34-29301)

The Commission has granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-91-25) that extends for six months an interim ban on automated update of quotations (autoquoting) currently in place on the NASDAQ system. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 17. (Rel. 34-29304)

## PARTIAL ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted partial accelerated approval for a temporary period ending on May 24, 1993 to certain portions of a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-91-21) to amend several Exchange Rules. The proposed rule change would allow the PSE to provide primary market protection to orders that have been entered with the PSE but are designated to receive the execution price that will be established in the primary market's after-hours session. (Rel. 34-29305)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
