## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION AGAINST LOUIS BORGET AND THOMAS MASTROENI

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on July 10 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia alleging that Louis J. Borget (Borget) and Thomas N. Mastroeni (Mastroeni) committed and aided and abetted violations of antifraud and reporting provisions of the Exchange Act. These violations related to disclosures by Enron Corp. (Enron) contained in certain of its reports on Forms 10-K and 10-Q during 1985, 1986 and 1987. Borget and Mastroeni, without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, consented to the entry of a final judgment enjoining them from violating Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 13b2-1 thereunder. Borget and Mastroeni are also enjoined from aiding and abetting violations of Section 13(a) and 13(b)(2)(A) and (B) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13a-1, 13a-13 and 12b-20 thereunder.

The Commission alleges that, beginning in or about October 1985, Borget, as the president, chief executive officer, and a director of Enron's speculative petroleum products trading subsidiary, Enron Oil Corporation (Enron Oil), and Mastroeni, as a vice president, secretary and treasurer of Enron Oil, engaged in petroleum trading well beyond Enron's established trading limits. It is also alleged that they concealed this overtrading from Enron and its auditors through falsification of records and the execution of sham trades with various trading companies. According to the Commission's complaint, Borget and Mastroeni continued their scheme of overtrading and concealment thereof until October 1987. As a result of the scheme, Enron filed with the Commission financial statements which materially misstated Enron's net income for the following fiscal periods: 1985, 1986, the first quarter of 1986, the third quarter of 1986, the first quarter of 1987 and the second quarter of 1987. ## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-91-19) under Rule 19b-4 to expand the automatic execution feature of the PHLX's Automated Options Market (AUTOM) system to include all strike prices. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-29413)

The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board has filed a proposed rule change (SR-MSRB-91-4) under Rule 19b-4 to amend the MSRB's Arbitration Code and Rule A-16 on arbitration fees and deposits. The Board has requested that the Commission delay the effectiveness of the proposed rule change for a period of 30 days following the date of approval in order to allow the MSRB time to alert dealers and the public of the rule change. The proposed rule change is intended to conform the provisions of the MSRB's Arbitration Code and arbitration fees to recent amendments to the Uniform Code approved by the Securities Industry Conference on Arbitration. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-29420)

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PHLX-91-11) under Rule 19b-4 to provide for the retention of book priority for orders that are subject to a cancel or replacement process. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-29424)

#### WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

On August 18, 1989 and November 9, 1989, the Intermarket Clearing Corporation filed proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4 relating to the eligibility of certain treasury securities futures contracts for cross-margining (SR-ICC-89-03) and to the delivery and settlement of such contracts (SR-ICC-89-05). On July 3, 1991, ICC withdrew both proposals. Publication of the notice of withdrawal of the proposed rule changes is expected to appear in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-29421)

#### WITHDRAWAL OF REGISTRATION AS A NATIONAL SECURITIES EXCHANGE

The Spokane Stock Exchange has filed a withdrawal from registration as a national securities exchange under Section 19(a)(3) of the Securities Exchange Act. The SSE ceased operations on May 24, 1991. Publication of the notice of withdrawal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-29422)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
