COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

CHAIRMAN LEVITT COMMENDS THE WORKING GROUPS ON AFTER-HOURS TRADING

Chairman Arthur Levitt today praised the National Association of Securities Dealers and the New York Stock Exchange, as well as their Working Groups on After-Hours Trading, for their leadership roles in formulating key policy recommendations regarding trading in the after-hours market.

Reports were issued today to the NASD and NYSE by three of the Working Groups (Investor Protection and Education, Clearance and Settlement and Operations Issues, and Trading Conventions) that were established following the After-Hours Summit hosted by Chairman Levitt, NASD Chairman Frank Zarb, and NYSE Chairman Richard Grasso on June 30, 1999.

Chairman Levitt said, "These reports provide valuable insights into issues that must be considered before the major securities markets open for extended trading. The report on investor education and protection also contains recommendations that are relevant to today's trading environment. I also reaffirm that broker-dealers have a clear duty to ensure that customers' orders receive best executions regardless of the time of day and to provide their customers with essential information to make informed choices about participating in after-hours trading."

Chairman Levitt particularly commended the Chairs of the Working Groups for successfully canvassing the views of a broad cross-section of the industry and consumer groups on issues that need to be addressed to protect investors and maintain the orderly operation of critical systems for trading, market transparency, and clearance and settlement operations.

The reports will be made available for public comment on the NASD and NYSE web sites. In particular, the NASD and NYSE intend to reach out over the next few months to corporate issuers, market participants, and consumer groups to consider specific issues raised by late-day corporate news announcements. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSION SUSTAINS IN PART NASD FINDINGS OF VIOLATIONS AGAINST COASTLINE FINANCIAL INC. AND DONALD ALLYSON WILLIAMS AND SUSTAINS SANCTIONS IMPOSED

The Commission has sustained in part the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc.'s (NASD) disciplinary action against Coastline Financial Inc., an NASD member, and Donald Allyson Williams, president and sole owner of Coastline. The Commission affirmed the NASD's findings that Coastline and Williams made material misstatements to forty-eight customers as to the security of promissory notes issued by Southern California Management and Acquisitions, Inc. (SCMA). However, the Commission determined that the NASD failed to establish that proceeding against SCMA, in the event SCMA defaulted on the notes, would have proven "futile." The NASD censured Coastline and Williams and fined them \$50,000 jointly and severally. Coastline was also expelled from NASD membership and ordered to repay any outstanding promissory notes that were the subject of the proceeding. Williams was also permanently barred in all capacities. Given the number of transactions and the seriousness of the misrepresentations, the Commission sustained all sanctions and determined that they were neither excessive nor oppressive. FEDERAL JUDGE PERMANENTLY ENJOINS INTERNATIONAL HERITAGE, INC., INTERNATIONAL HERITAGE, INCORPORATED, AND STANLEY VAN ETTEN

The Commission announced today that the Honorable Richard W. Story, United States District Judge for the Northern District of Georgia, entered a Consent Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction as to Defendants International Heritage, Inc. (IHI), International Heritage, Incorporated (IHI Incorporated), and Stanley H. Van Etten (Van Etten). IHI was enjoined from further violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; IHI Incorporated was enjoined from further violations of Section 10(b) and 15(d) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 15d-11 thereunder; and Van Etten was enjoined from further violations of Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act, and Sections 10(b) and 15(d) of the Exchange Act and Rules 10b-5 and 15d-1 thereunder.

The Court ordered disgorgement against IHI in the amount of \$6,533,179, of which \$4.1 million may be satisfied from a posted surety bond. The Court ordered disgorgement against Van Etten in the amount of \$7,630,450, but due to a demonstrated inability to pay, the Court ordered Van Etten to pay \$150,000, required Van Etten to waive certain claims against the bankruptcy estate of IHI, and waived payment of the remaining disgorgement, pre-judgment and post-judgment interest. IHI, IHI Incorporated, and Van Etten consented to the entries of the judgments without admitting or denying any of the allegations of the Commission's complaints. The

Court made specific provisions for the distributions of disgorgement funds. The Court did not impose civil penalties against IHI, IHI Incorporated, or Van Etten based upon their demonstrated inability to pay.

The Commission's complaint, filed on March 16, 1998, alleged that beginning in April, 1995, IHI, a North Carolina corporation, through Van Etten and others, solicited individuals throughout the United States to invest in a pyramid scheme through misleading promotional materials, meetings, videotapes, internet web pages, and national conference calls to increase investor interest. IHI raised more than \$150 million from over 155,000 investors. The complaint alleged that interests in the program, which were described by IHI as business centers, were securities. In addition to selling interests in the pyramid scheme, between July 17, 1997 and November 1, 1997, the defendants sold \$5 million in notes convertible into shares of IHI common stock. The defendants knowingly misrepresented IHI's financial condition to investors and concealed the fact that IHI was operating a pyramid scheme. Van Etten was a founder and director of IHI. [SEC v. SEC FILES COMPLAINT AGAINST DEBISYS AND ITS PRINCIPALS

On October 7, the Commission sued Debisys, Inc., and its principals Mark T. Flanagan and James S. Eberhart, both of Costa Mesa, California, for securities fraud. The complaint alleges that from January through July 1997, Defendants fraudulently sold unregistered securities and raised \$2.3 million from 150 investors nationwide. Defendants sold a sale-leaseback program for point-of-sale terminals. The complaint alleges that Defendants falsely represented that they would use investor funds to purchase terminals, when, in fact, approximately 66 percent of investor funds were used for sales commissions, administrative costs, and "returns" to investors. Debisys and Flanagan consented to the entry of permanent injunctions against violations of the antifraud, securities registration, and broker-dealer registration provisions of Sections 5(a), 5(c), and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. Flanagan's settlement did not require him to pay penalties because he demonstrated that he was not able to pay them. The complaint also seeks a permanent injunction, disgorgement, and civil penalties against Eberhart for the same violations. [SEC v. Debisys, Inc., Mark T. Flanagan, and James S.
