Dear Ms. Harmon:

Great American Life Insurance Company ("GALIC") respectfully requests that the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") extend the period of time for filing comments on Release Nos.: 33-8933 and 43-58022 proposing, among other things, Rule 151A under the Securities Act of 1933 (the "Proposal") from September 10, 2008 to December 10, 2008. For the reasons stated herein, GALIC believes that additional time is both necessary and appropriate.

The Proposal would fundamentally alter the basic legal test used to determine whether fixed annuities qualify for the statutory exclusion set forth in Section 3(a)(8) of the Securities Act of 1933. GALIC believes such a change warrants careful analysis and the SEC will benefit from thorough, well-reasoned comments rather than hurried comments to meet a short deadline.

GALIC began consideration of the Proposal immediately upon issuance. However, the complex issues the Proposal raises coupled with the significant impact it would have on GALIC's business operations requires research and analysis. The timing of the Proposal during the summer vacation period has made this effort all the more difficult. It is important that GALIC and the industry as a whole be granted sufficient time to complete the deliberative process necessary for a fully informed understanding of the Proposal.
