The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about August 1, 2007, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., by force, violence and intimidation did take from the person and presence of another, approximately \$5,880.00 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Chase Bank, located at 3783 Veterans Blvd.,

Metairie, Louisiana, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT 2

On or about August 27, 2007, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., by force, violence and intimidation did take from the person and presence of another, approximately \$44,550.00 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Chase Bank, located at 104 West Airline Highway, Laplace, Louisiana, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT 3

On or about February 14, 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., by force, violence and intimidation did take from the person and presence of another, approximately \$19,156.20 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Chase Bank, located at 12515 Airline Highway, Destrehan, Louisiana, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT 4

On or about February 27, 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., by force, violence and intimidation did take from the person and

presence of another, approximately \$20.00 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Capital One Bank, located at 5696 Bullard Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2113(a).

COUNT 5


On or about May 21, 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., by force, violence and intimidation did take from the person and presence of another, approximately \$16,581.00 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Omni Bank, located at 2900 Ridgelake Drive, Metairie, Louisiana, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in committing the offense, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., did assault and put in jeopardy the life of another person by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a firearm; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and (d).

COUNT 6


On or about June 11, 2008, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., by force, violence and intimidation did take from the person and presence of another, approximately \$9,067 in United States currency, belonging to and in the care, custody, control, management and possession of the Chase Bank, located at 104 West Airline Highway Laplace, Louisiana, the deposits of which were insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, and in committing the offense, the defendant, ISAAC RONALD SKINNER, JR., did

assault and put in jeopardy the life of another person by the use of a dangerous weapon, that is, a firearm; all in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2113(a) and (d).
