**BALTIMORE MAN INDICTED FOR BANK ROBBERY ARRESTED**

BALTIMORE, Maryland - United States Attorney for the District of Maryland Rod J. Rosenstein and Acting Special Agent in Charge Joan Kvech O'Brien, Federal Bureau of Investigation - Baltimore Office, announce today that Kendall Charles Alexander, Sr., age 41, of Baltimore, Maryland was arrested by members of the FBI Bank Robbery Task Force. The FBI Task Force is made up of detectives from the Baltimore City Police Department, Baltimore County Police Department and Special Agents of the FBI.

Alexander was indicted on August 30, 2005 for bank robbery and has been a fugitive since that time. The search for Alexander has been featured in the local and national media, including America's Most Wanted.

"Fugitives who are featured on America's Most Wanted should know that citizens will join law enforcement officers in keeping on the lookout for them. We appreciate the assistance provided by America's Most Wanted and by the citizens who called in with helpful tips," stated U.S. Attorney Rod J. Rosenstein.

Acting SAC Joan O'Brien said, "I compliment the efforts of the task force detectives and agents who diligently pursued this case, resulting in today's arrest, and add my thanks to the citizens who continue to support law enforcement by remaining vigilant."

Alexander is expected to have an initial appearance tomorrow in U.S. District Court in Baltimore.
