**BANK ROBBER SENTENCED TO 10 YEARS IN PRISON**

BALTIMORE, Maryland - United States Attorney for the District of Maryland Rod J. Rosenstein announces that today U.S. District Court Judge William M. Nickerson sentenced Montrell Smiley, age 35, of Baltimore to ten years in prison followed by 3 years of supervised release for interference with interstate commerce by robbery and bank robbery.

According to the agreed statement of facts presented to the court, Smiley entered the following business establishments and demanded money:
