

### The Kansas Association of Regional Councils



In 1971, an executive order laid the groundwork for the creation of additional multicounty regional planning commissions in the state by officially establishing eight planning and development regions. Since then, some of these regional organizations have disbanded.

#### Missouri Association of Councils of Government




