Albert Teplin is an economist, consultant, and director for two public companies. Dr. Teplin is chair of the audit committee and serves on the human resources committee for Viad Corp, an S&P SmallCap 600 company that provides services that address the needs of trade show organizers and exhibitors, as well as travel and recreation services in the United States and Canada.
