**RECYCLABLE MATERIALS**  
PAPER PRODUCTS, GLASS BOTTLES, POLYSTYRENE, PLASTICS, ALUMINUM AND TIN CANS, SOAP METALS, etc.  
(These should be brought to recycling plants)

**COMPOSTABLE or BIODEGRADABLE MATERIALS**  
FOOD LEFTOVERS, YARD WASTES, FRUIT PEELS, VEGETABLE TRIMMINGS, etc.  
(These should be brought to composting facilities)

**NON-RECYCLABLE or RESIDUAL WASTE**  
SOILED PLASTIC BAGS, USED BATTERIES, FILM NEGATIVES, BROKEN CERAMICS, BAGS, ALUMINUM FOIL, etc.  
(These should be brought to the landfill)

**SPECIAL WASTE**  
USED BATTERIES, CHEMICAL SPRAY CANS, PAINT CANS, USED ENGINE OIL, MEDICAL WASTES SUCH AS NEEDLES, SYRINGES, SCALPES, etc.  
(These should be brought to treatment facilities)

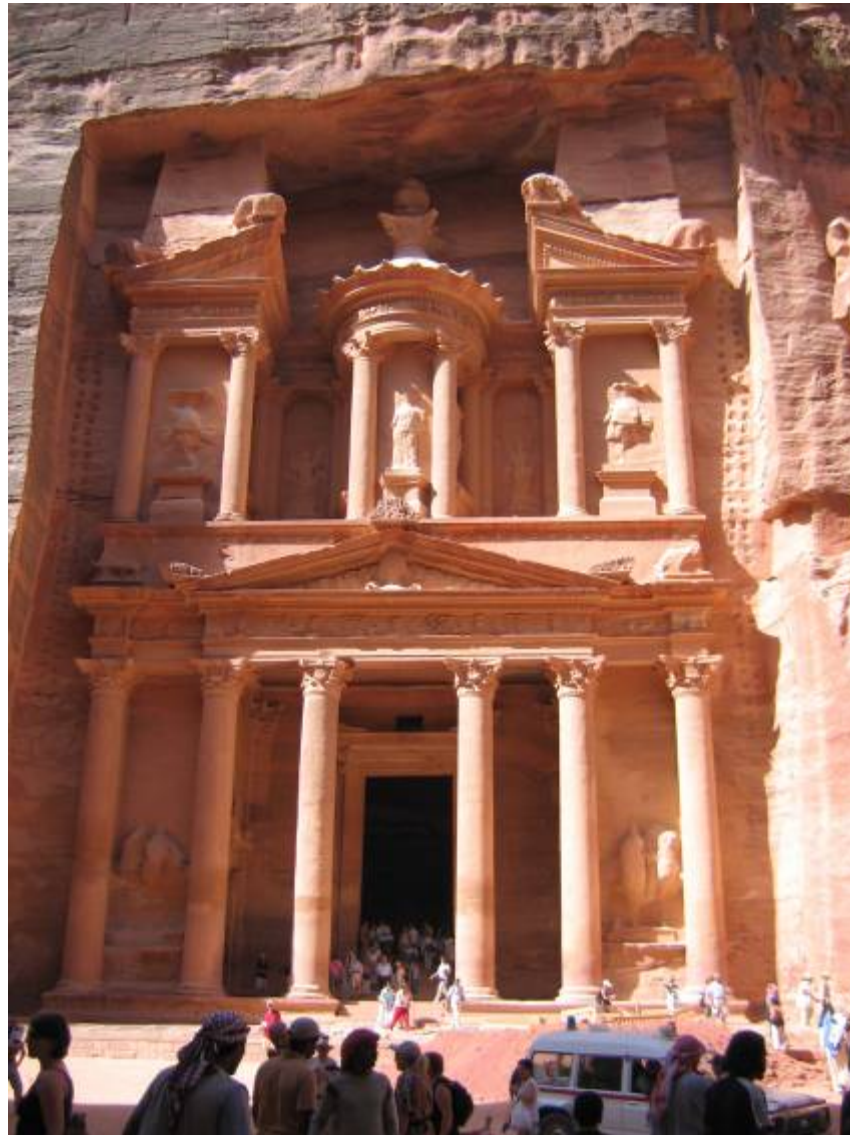
