Subject: Clarification of Issuance of Revised ADS 103 (Delegations of Authority)

This notice is to clarify paragraph (c) of the 08/14/2008 policy notice message. ADS 103 (Delegations of Authority) has been revised to permit non-U.S. Direct Hire (non-USDH) employees to supervise the daily work activities of U.S. Direct Hire (USDH) employees on a limited basis, not to exceed 60 days in any 180 day period, to cover a temporary USDH absence or when both non-USDH and USDH employees are participating in emergency temporary duty assignments, such as Disaster Assistance Response Team (DART) deployments. See ADS 103.3.1.1.b.
