<p>Indicator 12: Percent of children referred by Part C prior to age 3 and who are found eligible for Part B, and who have an individualized education program (IEP) developed and implemented by their third birthdays.</p>	<p>Other: Incomplete baseline data – on page 50 of the SPP, the State reported that 83.4% of children referred to Part B from Part C had eligibility determined by their third birthday. However, the baseline data did not include the number of children referred to Part B (who had been served in Part C), the number of those referred that were determined to be NOT eligible, and of those that were found to be eligible, the number who had an IEP developed and implemented by the third birthday. Further, the State did not, as required, account for children as required under the measurement for this indicator, including the range of days beyond the third birthday (if any) when eligibility was determined and reasons for delays.</p>	<p>The State must include, in the FFY 2005 APR, due February 1, 2007, both complete baseline data from FFY 2004 (July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2005) and progress data from FFY 2005 (July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006). Failure to include these data may affect OSEP's determination in 2007 of the State's status under section 616(d) of the IDEA.</p> <p>Under Indicator 12, the State must account for children as required under the measurement for this indicator, including the range of days beyond the third birthday (if any) when eligibility was determined and reasons for delays.</p>
