The State reported a 48% level of compliance for indicator 12 in the SPP, specifically the requirement at 34 CFR §300.132.</p>	<p>The State submitted a plan for ensuring noncompliance in the SPP.</p>	<p>The State must ensure that this noncompliance is corrected and include data in the APR, due February 1, 2007, that demonstrate compliance with this requirement. The State should review and, if necessary revise, its improvement strategies included in the SPP to ensure they will enable the State to include data in the APR that demonstrate full compliance with this requirement. Failure to demonstrate compliance at that time may affect OSEP's determination of the State's status under section 616(d) of the IDEA.</p>
