Joint Operations Information Center- Afghanistan (JIOC-A)

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Afghanistan District, intends to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) to award one Firm Fixed Price (FFP) contract for the construction of the Joint Operations Information Center- Afghanistan (JIOC-A) building at the International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) Compound in Kabul, Afghanistan. Work consists of the planning, design and construction (Design-Build) of office facilities. Facility is approximately 1071 square meters. Site is approximately 893 square meters. Work includes all site work, utilities, site improvements, storm drain system, roads, parking, walkways, lighting and entry control necessary for a fully functional building and fenced compound. The Contractor shall perform all site surveys (topographic, utility, etc.) to determine the existing site conditions. Building shall be a prefabricated metal structure on a concrete slab on grade with insulated walls and roof and shall be two stories above grade.

This procurement shall be conducted in accordance with the United States Federal Acquisition (FAR) regulations. The magnitude of this contract action is estimated to be between U.S. dollars \$1,000,000 and \$5,000,000. The solicitation will be evaluated using the Best value Trade-off method. It is anticipated that the solicitation will be released on or about 7 April 2007.
