Questions on the TSR Registry

First, let me say that, speaking as a consumer, I applaud the TSR ruling.

Here are a few questions:

- 1) Is there any restriction to my setting up a business whereby I pay the access fee, cache the information for the Area Codes I have access to, on perhaps a monthly basis and offer my customers access to my cached data?
- 1.a) A variation on 1) is that I would like to offer a scrubbing service so that my customers don't have to access the data directly, my systems access the registry data at the FTC site using my account then scrub my customers lists and return these scrubbed lists to them.
- 2) Are there bandwidth access restrictions? How many times per day/week/month, etc, can my systems access the registry data at the FTC site to retrieve information using my account number?
- 2.a) If there is a restriction, then how can I guarantee that I nor one of my customers is always in compliance with the registry data at the FTC site information? So for example, if I just accessed the site, then 5 minutes later someone adds their phone number to the registry, then for the intervening period of time prior to my next access to the registry; I or my customers are potentially in violation of the TSR law. Is that correct?
