**INDIANAPOLIS WOMAN SENTENCED  
FOR FALSE STATEMENTS TO IRS**

**PRESS RELEASE**

Susan W. Brooks, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Indiana, announced that ROBIN Y. GREEN, 46, Indianapolis, Indiana, was sentenced to 36 months probation today by U.S. District Judge David F. Hamilton following her guilty plea to making a false statement to the federal government. This case was the result of a investigation by the Internal Revenue Service, Office of Inspector General.

Robin Green, an employee of a business consulting firm in Indianapolis, represented to the I.R.S. that she was a certified public accountant in order to represent a client before the IRS. When the IRS asked for documentation to support her claim that she was a CPA she provided two forms showing she was an accountant in Virginia. Investigation by the IRS discovered that Ms. Green had obtained the forms from the Virginia Board of Accountancy

website and falsified the information on them, including creating a license number for herself in Virginia.

According to Assistant United States Attorney Winfield D. Ong, who prosecuted the case for the government, Judge Hamilton also imposed a fine of \$5,000 and also required that Ms. Green cooperate with the IRS in identifying and revoking all powers of attorney she may have pending with the IRS on behalf of clients.
