**NEWS RELEASE**

Paul J. McNulty, United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia, announced today that James V. Dean, age forty, of Haymarket, Virginia, was indicted today on six counts of filing false tax returns and three counts of aiding and assisting the preparation of false tax returns. Arraignment is scheduled for January 27, 2003, in Alexandria.

According to the indictment, Dean operated Jetco Enterprises, Inc., a commercial roofing business. Dean is alleged to have understated the amount of wages Jetco paid to its employees in order to avoid the payment of federal employment taxes. The indictment charges that Dean filed or caused the filing of false employer quarterly tax forms for the years 1996 through 1998. The indictment further alleges that Dean misrepresented the amount of employee wages by a total amount of \$377,500 and that the misrepresentation resulted in the underpayment of federal taxes by Jetco Enterprises of approximately \$53,000.

The investigation was conducted by special agents of the Criminal Investigation Division of the Internal Revenue Service. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Dana J. Boente.
