This draft document discusses the post construction completion (PCC) strategy, which is a management framework of goals with recommended approaches and initiatives designed to provide greater assurance that remedies put in place under CERCLA remain protective over the long-term. This document is expected to be finalized in late summer 2005 but is made available to interested parties while the review is underway.
