## What would have been helpful to know when starting work with USAID?

- 1. Request for Applications
  - •What is the dollar amount offered?
  - •How many organizations have applied in the past?
  - •What is the acceptance rate? (50%, 25%, 10%, 5%)

- 2. What are the requirements for accounting for grants, co-operative agreements?
  - Our PVO had a USAID grant, but it took 6 to 9 months to conduct the assessment of the NGOs accounting system to be registered!
  - The Microfinance Institution starved in the meantime!

#### 3. DIP workshop

- Dialog with USAID on the realities of the situation
- How can you develop a collegial relationship with the USAID technical officer to share the realities of what is happening in the project?
  - A colleague versus a cop
  - Working shoulder to shoulder

- 4. How to work more closely with corporations
  - USAID Global Development Alliance

Large scale and widespread entrepreneurship is at the heart of the solution to poverty."

#### 5. Democracy and Governance

- Helpful to know how Associations of Local NGOs such as Microfinance Associations can advocate with their local and national governments to have changes in legislation and government application of the law.
- E.g. A Microfinance Institution
   Association said that it has not received any change in supervision with the Central Bank even after many meetings.
