






### EDC Customer Orders and inquiries Fiscal Years 99 2000






## EDC Orders via Web Interface FY2000






### EDC Sales \* Fisca Years 1973 - 2000






### **EDC Film Diapositive Workload**






### Aerial Photographic Data Sales Fiscal Years 1973 - 2000

### Landsat Sales (\$) \* Fisca Years 1973 - 2000



#### **Section IV**

#### **USGS EDC Archives and Data Bases**

This section describes those data archives, both digital and photographic, that are maintained by the USGS EDC to preserve and catalog remotely sensed, cartographic, and other earth science data. In addition, several data bases refer to data held elsewhere that are of interest to USGS EDC customers.

As of the end of fiscal year 2000, the USGS EDC had archived more than 12.3 million frames of photographic data and 237,170 tapes. This includes nearly 2.9 million frames of Landsat photographic data and 22,870 Landsat data tapes. The International Landsat Data Base maintained by the USGS edc refers to more than 1 million Landsat scenes archived in the United States, and more than 2.6 million scenes of Landsat Data held by foreign ground stations.

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#### **Section I**

#### **Products And Services**

In fiscal year 2000, the USGS EDC produced and distributed nearly \$19 million worth of products and services. Of the total, nearly \$13.4 million was in direct sales to outside customers and over \$600,000 was in products and services provided through USGS EDC cooperative repay projects, for a "reimbursable" total of over \$14 million. The remaining \$4.8 million was for products and services distributed to users within the U.S. Geological Survey. In addition, more than 10.6 million files of digital cartographic data, totaling 6.7 terabytes were distributed free of charge via the Internet.
