Top 25 Partners are Partners whose annual green power purchase is the largest, and whose green power purchase has been completed. Their actions are helping drive the development of new renewable energy sources for electricity generation. Combined, their purchases amount to 1.3 million megawatt-hours (MWh) annually, which is approximately 60 percent of the green power commitments made by all Partners.
