
RE: EPA's Determination of the Completion of the Modeling Study

This letter provides notification that EPA has made the determination that the Peer Review Process on Validation of EPA's model has been completed. In accordance with Paragraph 22.j of the Consent Decree and Part II, Section E. of the Reissued RCRA Permit (Appendix G to the Consent Decree), GE shall submit to EPA, with copies to the Trustees, MADEP and CTDEP, a Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Proposal within 90 days of receipt of this letter and the above-mentioned documents.
