Dear Mr. Gates:

This letter contains the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) approval of the above-referenced *East Street Area 2-North Removal Action Area Revised Supplemental Information Package* (the "Revised SIP") dated January 2, 2008. The Revised SIP is subject to the terms and conditions specified in the Consent Decree (CD) that was entered in U.S. District Court on October 27, 2000.

Pursuant to Paragraph 73 of the CD, EPA, after consultation with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MDEP), approves the above-referenced submittal.

Please note that pursuant to the conditions of EPA's August 20, 2007, Conditional Approval of GE's Final Removal Design/Removal Action Work Plan Addendum for East Street Area 2-North, GE is required to conduct pavement repair and replacement activities either prior to the initiation of, during, or within 30 days of the conclusion of the soil excavation and removal activities at East Street Area 2-North. Based on the project schedule submitted along with the Revised SIP, 30 days following the conclusion of soil removal activities would be June 9, 2008. This requirement does not apply to those areas of pavement that potentially could be impacted or damaged by activities associated with the demolition of buildings 7, 17, 17-C, 19, 11, and 16, which shall be repaired and paved within 30 days of the conclusion of the demolition activities.

EPA reserves all of its rights under the CD, including but not limited to, the right to perform additional sampling and/or require additional sampling or Response Actions, if necessary, to meet the requirements of the CD.
