CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION FOR THE FORMER OXBOW AREAS A AND C REMOVAL ACTION PERFORMED BY THE GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY AT THE GE-PITTSFIELD/HOUSATONIC RIVER SITE PITTSFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS

Pursuant to Paragraph 88.b of the Consent Decree for the GE-Pittsfield/Housatonic River Site, which was entered by the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts on October 27, 2000 ("Consent Decree"), the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") hereby certifies, based upon the *Final Completion Report for Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action*, dated May 2008, prepared and submitted by the General Electric Company, that the Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action, excluding Post-Removal Site Control activities, has been performed in accordance with the Consent Decree and that the soil-related Performance Standards for the Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action have been achieved. The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection has reviewed the above-referenced *Final Completion Report* and concurs with EPA that the Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action, excluding Post-Removal Site Control activities, has been performed in accordance with the Consent Decree and that the soil-related Performance Standards for the Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action have been achieved.

This certificate constitutes the Certificate of Completion for the Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action for purposes of the Consent Decree. This Certificate of Completion shall not discharge, limit, or affect any of the General Electric Company's remaining obligations under the Consent Decree, including without limitation, obligations relating to Post-Removal Site Control and groundwater. In addition, this Certificate of Completion does not alter any rights reserved by the United States under the Consent Decree. This certificate constitutes a finding by EPA that the Former Oxbow Areas A and C Removal Action, as described in the above-referenced *Final Completion Report*, is consistent with the National Contingency Plan.
