Former Oxbow Areas J and K (GECD420) Summary of October 2007 Inspection Activities

Dear Mr. Hull:

On October 16, 2007, the General Electric Company (GE) performed the required post-remediation inspection of the properties within Former Oxbow Areas J and K at which remediation activities have been performed. As shown on Figure 1, Former Oxbow Areas J and K include six commercial parcels (four of which have recreational areas within them), three recreational parcels, and two residential parcels. In accordance with GE's Addendum to Final Removal Design/Removal Action Work Plan for Former Oxbow Areas J and K (Final RD/RA Work Plan Addendum), which was submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in April 2006 and conditionally approved by EPA on June 23, 2006, GE conducted remediation activities at all six of the commercial parcels (Parcels K10-13-1, K10-12-1, K10-11-2, K10-11-3, and K10-11-5) and one residential property (Parcel K10-10-6). These remediation activities were completed in summer 2006. Vegetation restoration activities were subsequently conducted at these properties in accordance with the revised Vegetation Restoration Plan for Former Oxbow Areas J and K, provided in Attachment 2 to GE's October 5, 2006 Addendum to Supplemental Information Package.

GE conducted the previous post-remediation inspections of these properties on November 1, 2006 and May 29, 2007. Summaries of the above-referenced inspection activities were submitted to EPA in letters dated January 3, 2007 and July 11, 2007 respectively. Inspections were conducted in accordance with the Post-Removal Site Control Plan contained in Attachment E to GE's Final RD/RA Work Plan, as revised and set forth in Attachment G to the Final RD/RA Work Plan Addendum. Consistent with the previous inspections, this inspection was performed for areas that were backfilled and restored during the implementation of the remediation actions.

Summary of Inspection Activities

The October 2007 inspection consisted of visual observations of the backfilled/restored areas, focusing on the following: (a) erosion controls to verify their continued effectiveness until such time as vegetation is sufficiently established; (b) any areas where excessive settlement has occurred relative to the surrounding areas; (c) any drainage or growth problems due to possible over-compaction of backfill materials; and (d) other conditions that could jeopardize the completed remediation. The inspection also evaluated whether the vegetation that has been planted or seeded is growing as anticipated and providing the desired degree of erosion control.

The October 2007 inspection also included observations of properties/areas at which the need for follow-up activities had been identified during the prior inspection. As indicated in GE's July 11, 2007 report related to the May 2007 inspection, follow-up activities included: seeding the six-foot excavation area on Parcel K10-11-3; addressing erosion along the Housatonic River bank on Parcels K10-11-3 and K10-11-5; repairing or replacing beaver controls on Parcel K10-12-1 (completed September 2007); monitoring stressed trees on Parcels K10-10-6 and K10-11-2; and monitoring stressed vegetation on Parcel K10-11-5. All of these activities have been addressed except seeding on Parcel K10-11-3. Recent observations indicate that vegetation is growing, therefore seeding is not necessary at this time. Also, rip-rap was installed along the riverbank on Parcels K10-11-3 and K10-11-5 during the week of October 15, 2007; therefore no further maintenance is required. This area will continue to be monitored for signs of erosion.

The results of the October 2007 inspection are included in an Inspection Summary and Checklist for each property subject to inspection (Attachment A). These forms will also be used in the future to continue to document such inspections and track the completion of identified maintenance activities.

Summary of Observations During Inspection

As indicated on the attached forms, the October 2007 inspection identified the need to conduct the following maintenance activities:

- Install tree guards on saplings on Parcel K10-11-2;
- Install two elm trees on Parcels K10-10-6 and two to four cottonwood trees on Parcel K10-12-1; and
- Monitor trees on Parcels K10-10-6 and K10-11-5.

Maintenance activities identified above will be conducted prior to the fall 2008 inspection.

Schedule for Future Inspections

In accordance with Technical Attachment J to the SOW, the backfilled/restored areas are to be inspected approximately every 6 months for a period of one year and annually thereafter (subject to EPA approval of a different frequency). Future inspections are anticipated to occur in the fall of each year. Following each inspection, an inspection report will be prepared and submitted to EPA.

GE submitted a draft Final Completion Report to EPA in July 2007. Upon receiving EPA comments on the draft Final Completion Report GE will schedule a pre-certification inspection with EPA and the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, and will thereafter submit the Final Completion Report to EPA. That report will include a final Post-Removal Site Control Plan for this area.


