Flush Responsibly

Whether your household wastewater goes to the local sewage treatment plant or a septic system, here are a few things that should **never** be flushed down the toilet or poured down the drain:



(these items can clog pipes and cause sewage backups) Disposable diapers, feminine hygiene products, and grease.

Household Hazardous Wastes Gasoline, oil,

(unless the treatment system is designed to handle these wastes, they can interfere with the treatment process and result in the release of pollutants into the environment) Gasoline, oil, antifreeze, pesticides, fertilizers, and paint.
